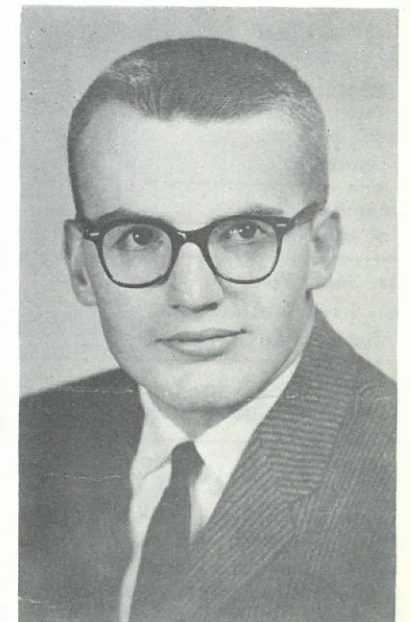
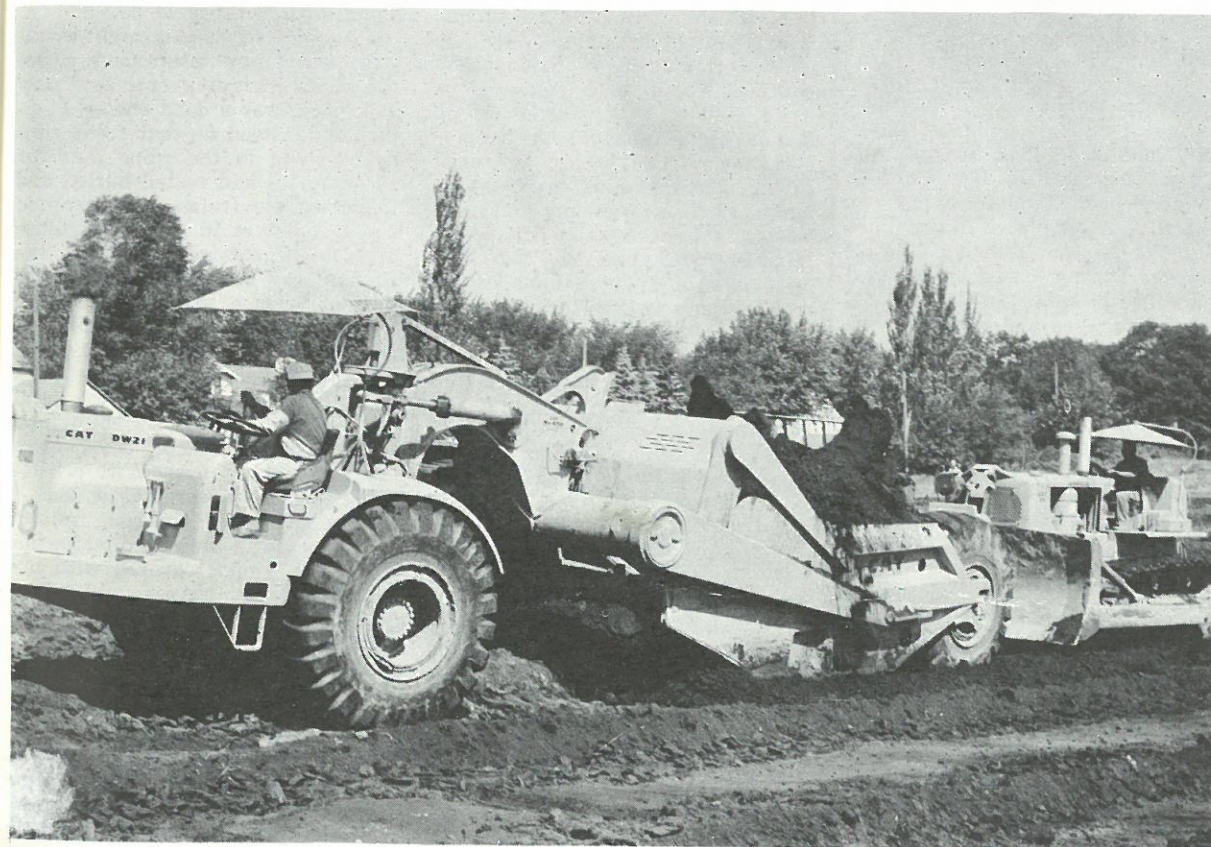

SCHOOL GETS TRACK

Academy Welcomes New Math Teacher

The mathematics staff of the Saint Paul Academy has been augmented this year by the addition of Mr. Allen H. Holmes. Mr. Holmes, a young man fresh from Carleton College, has many new and enthusiastic ideas about teaching math, and should be a valuable addition to the faculty. He will teach the lower school, taking the place of Mr. Dreschel.

Mr. Holmes was born in Toledo in 1937, but soon after, he moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan, which is his real home. He attended South High School in Grand Rapids, graduating in 1955. From there he went to Carleton, and received his B.A. degree last June. He taught summer school in Grand Rapids for the first six weeks of this summer, but S.P.A. will be his first actual teaching experience.

He, like Mr. Dreschel, is a proponent of the Illinois system in teaching mathematics. He writes, "Two years ago, at a mathematics teaching course at Carleton, I first

Work Progresses on New Track.

On the first of September, construction was completed on the school's new track. A joint project of the Gulliford Construction Company and Holm and Olson Nurseries, it combines the facilities of a track and football field, and is completely equipped for both. When ready for use, it will be one of the most modern tracks in the Twin Cities.

For a long time the track team has been dependent upon Macalester College and other schools in the league for meet and practice areas. Thus, timing and transportation

have always presented a major problem. Our track eliminates this, and gives the track team the added advantage of playing on the "home" field.

The track itself has been skillfully designed to promote maximum efficiency and ease in the use of its components. It features a 220-yard straightaway on which may be run all hurdle races and sprints, thus eliminating running these "on the curve." The pole vault, high jump, and broad jump pits have been placed so that they are in full view of the spectators

and within easy access of the participants. The discus and shot put are also only a few yards away, a novelty to many tracks. The varsity football field and goal posts will be located in the center of the quarter-mile oval-shaped track.

The track itself is made of several layers of crushed cinders. These will have to settle for about a year in order to insure the best possible running conditions. The football field has recently been seeded, so it will not be ready for use this season. The varsity will use the J.V. field this year fall.

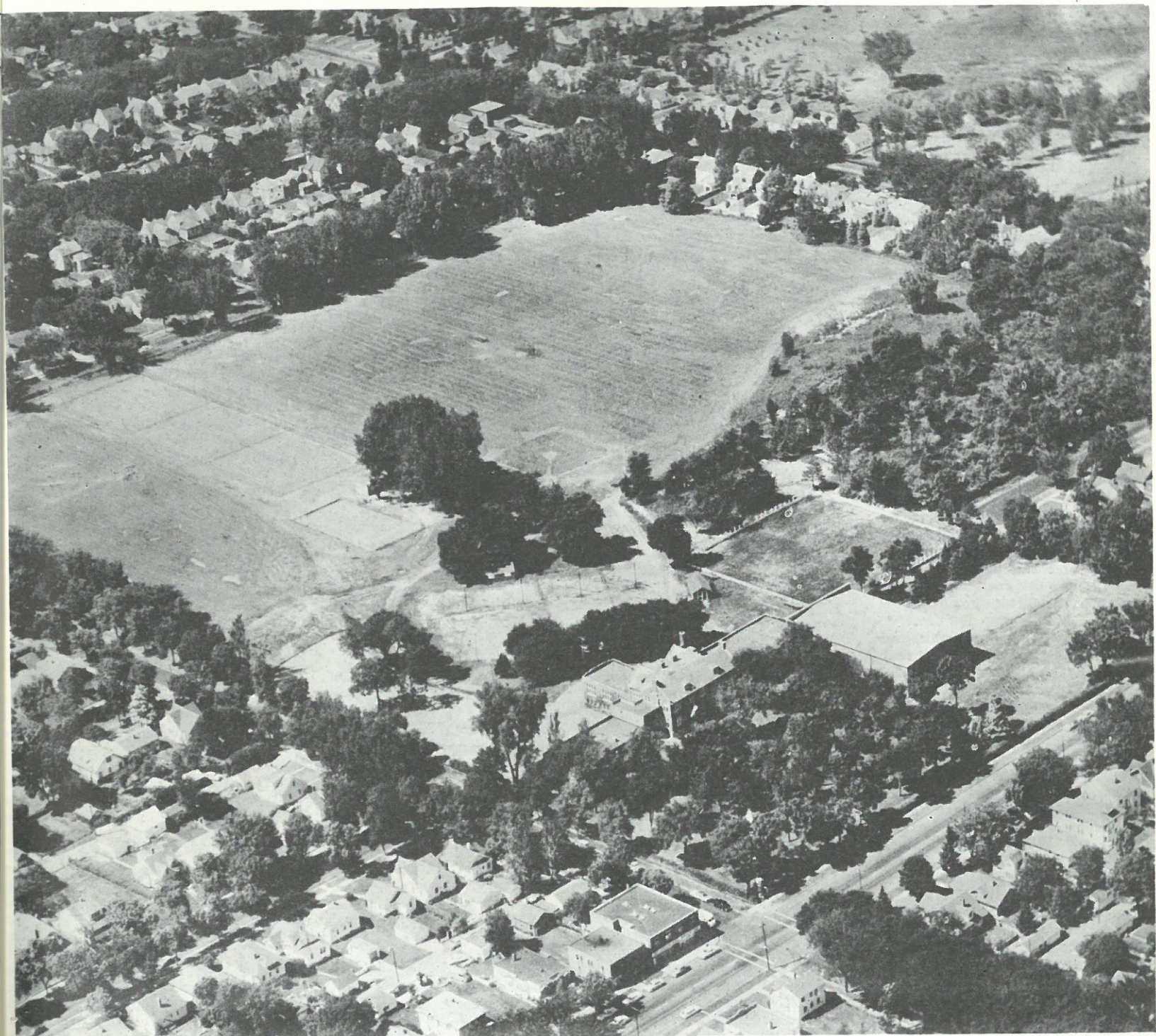

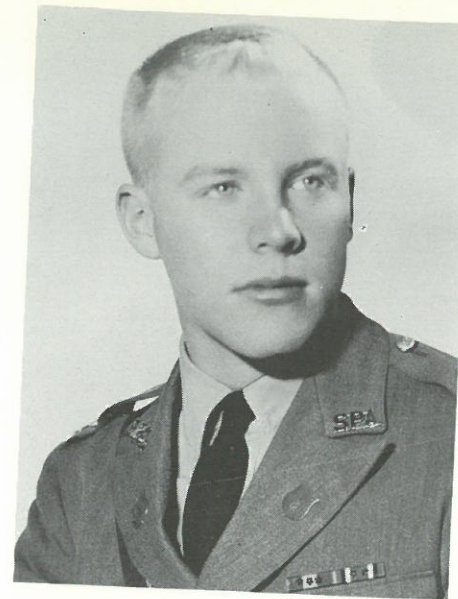
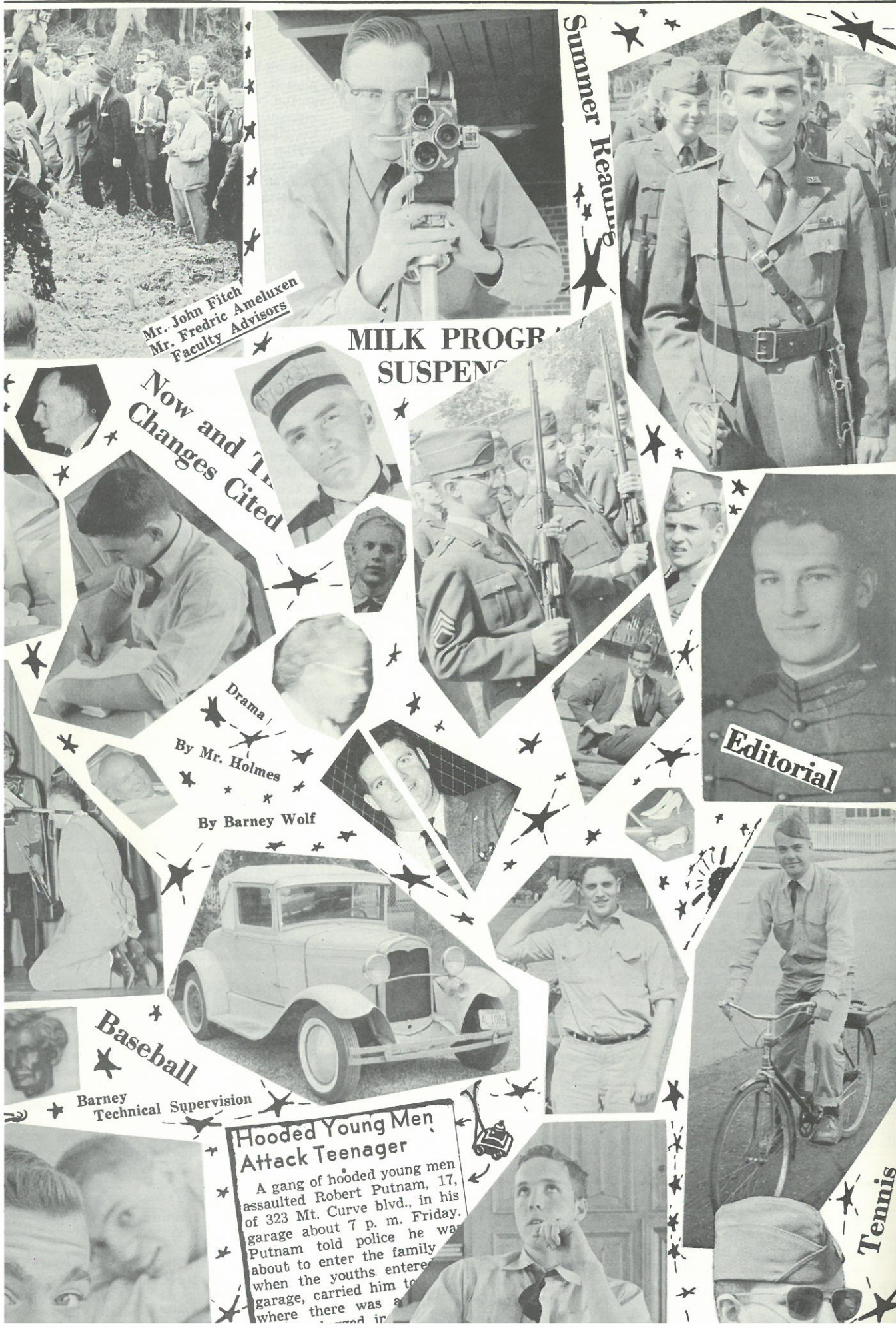
Recess at S.P.A. is not only a time of rest from studies and drinking milk, but also it is a superb time to participate in many invigorating games.

To play one of the more common games, one must interest the unsuspecting victim (it increases interest in

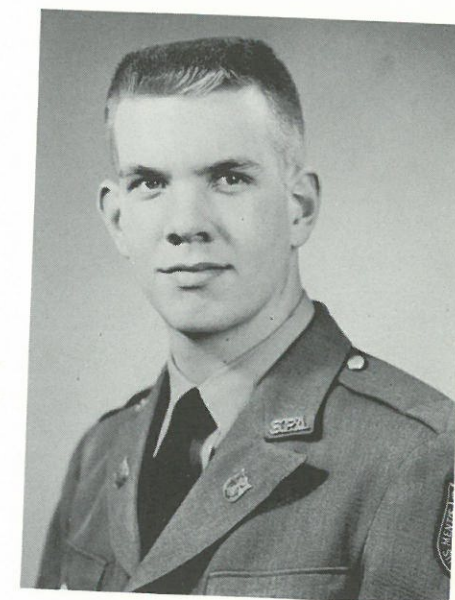
