A great big thank you from our team, to yours, for caring so much about your faculty and staff at **Kaufman ISD**. Through our combined efforts, it seems we have made a huge impact on the health and wellbeing of the faculty and their family members. Below, is the pathology report for your review.

Total # of people screened in December of 2019: 206 people

We found **88 people** with fatty plaque or calcification in the carotid arteries.

- **82 people with - Mild carotid artery disease, which is typically within the 1% to 39% stage of blockage.**
- **06 people with – Moderate carotid artery disease, which is typically in the 40% to 60% stage of blockage.**

We found **60 people** with **Thyroid** disease. **(Cysts, Nodules, or Masses)**

- **Thyroid disease can affect the hormones and metabolism. Thyroid nodules and masses identified, have a possibility of being cancerous.**

We found **77 people** with **Liver** disease. **(Fatty Liver, Cysts, or Masses)**

- **Undiagnosed, fatty liver disease can cause serious issues. Liver masses identified, have a possibility of being cancerous.**

We found **20 people** with **Gall Bladder** disease. **(Sludge or Stones)**

- **Sludge and stones in the gall bladder can cause serious digestive issues.**

We found **14 people** with **Kidney** disease. **(Hydronephrosis, Cysts, Masses, or Stones)**

- **Kidney disease can cause serious issues. Hydronephrosis is fluid on the kidneys. Stones can be very painful. Kidney masses identified, have a possibility of being cancerous.**

NATIONAL CALL

Tooth decay is the single most common, chronic disease afflicting children. More than 51 million school hours are lost each year due to children's oral health-related problems. National awareness of the importance of oral health has been brought to the forefront with the U.S. Surgeon General's report on health disparities, which cited "epidemic" levels among poor, rural and minority children.

BACKGROUND

In 1991, Colgate introduced Bright Smiles, Bright Futures (BSBF), an oral health education and prevention program designed to improve the oral health of underserved children. In the U.S., BSBF exposes ten million children and their families annually to positive oral health education messages and/or provides free dental screenings to children up to the age of 12. The primary BSBF goal is to teach children and their families how to maintain good oral health and prevent dental disease. Three major elements are at the core of the BSBF program, they are:

- **School Program/Curriculum** – BSBF provides Head Start programs and Kindergarten classes throughout the country with free, fun and engaging educational kits containing tools to teach children healthy practices for good oral health care and disease prevention. The BSBF website, www.colgatebsbf.com, contains intra-sites for parents, teachers and kids. Many valuable educational tools can be easily downloaded.
- **BSBF Dental Van Program** – "A dental office on wheels" - works with schools, community-based organizations, churches and others to provide free dental screenings, education and treatment referral for children up to 12 years old. Oral care kits containing toothpaste, toothbrush and educational information are provided to participating children.
- **Community Awareness Programs** - BSBF vans and staff participates in community events with a focus on raising awareness on good oral health care and disease prevention.

BSBF Mobile Dental Van: 38 feet long/ 10 feet wide (mirror to mirror)/ 12 feet, 6 inches high

Two Dental Chairs with a video waiting area, generator, retractable awning on passenger side, and wheelchair lift

Branded Tents for larger event/festival set up - 10 Feet x 10 Feet

Note: Total area required for set-up averages approximately 50'x20'
