

Amendment to SR05 Student behaviour policy 2.1

We have added additional information in our behaviour policy. Pupils will have additional expectations explained to them. Any children who do not adhere to social distancing guidance deliberately will be spoken to by their teacher and then referred to a senior member of staff. If this continues, the child's parents will be contacted.

The Behaviour Policy retains its current aims and objectives, however, the following information needs to be considered when applying our approach in the current climate. Rules on social distancing will be introduced and discussed with pupils on their return to school and communicated with parents. Prior to this they will be shared with all staff. These rules will be revisited with children on a regular basis along with gentle, age appropriate emphasis on the reasons behind the new rules. Sanctions will be imposed following our disciplinary policy. Children following the new rules will be encouraged and positively praised. Rules to ensure a safe environment during social distancing include but are not exclusive to:

- Pupils should try, wherever possible to maintain adequate social distances from each other.
- Entering and leaving school through designated gate at the designated time
- Following instructions on groupings
- Staying in designated areas during break times
- Using designated toilets
- Following the rules for moving around the school (for example following one-way systems)
- Children must have their own water bottle and must not share with others
- Children will only be allowed to use their own everyday resources and not to share with others (pens, pencils, rulers, scissors)
- Children must remain at their work station during their lessons
- Coughing and spitting at another person is not tolerated under normal circumstances but would be considered as more serious in the current situation
