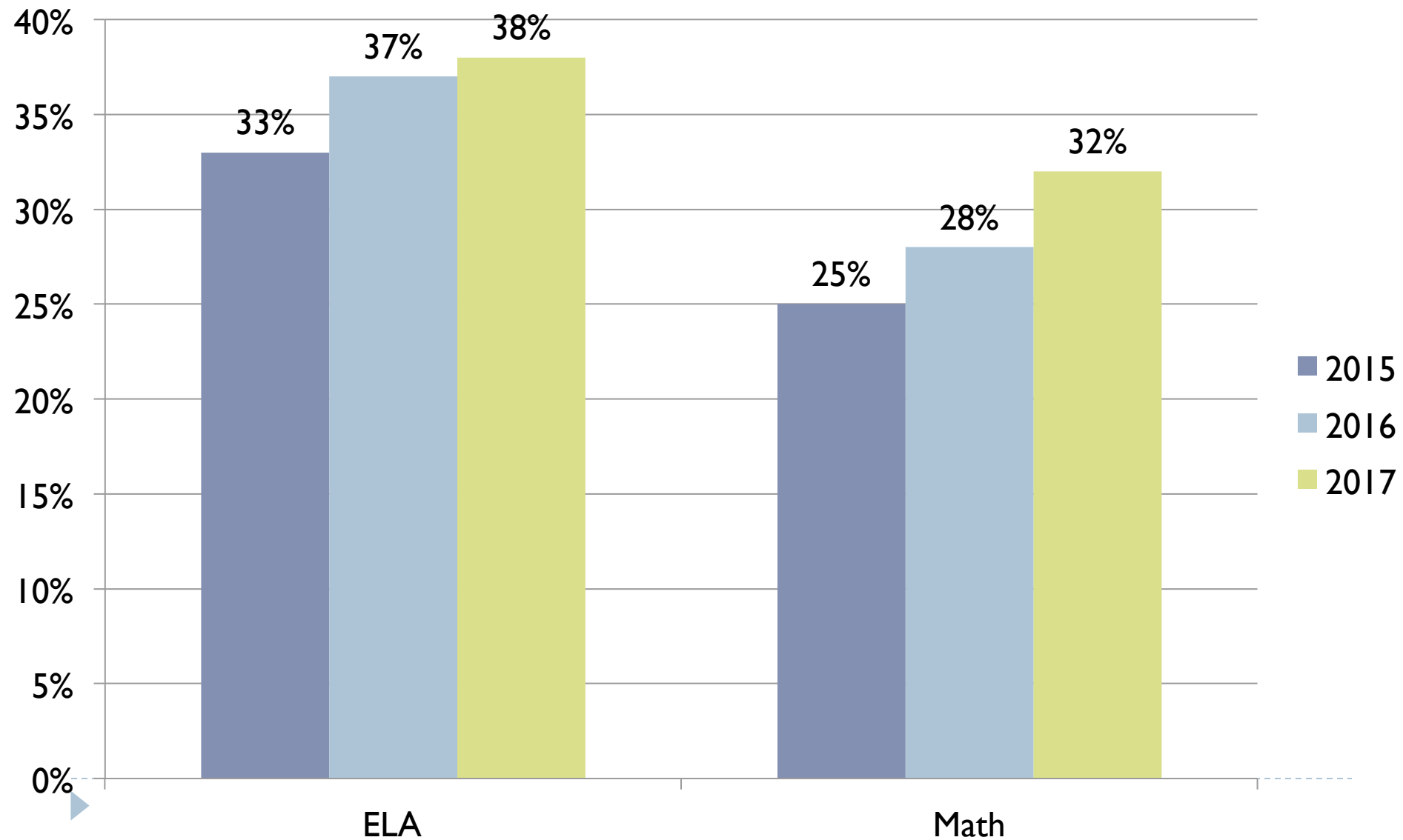

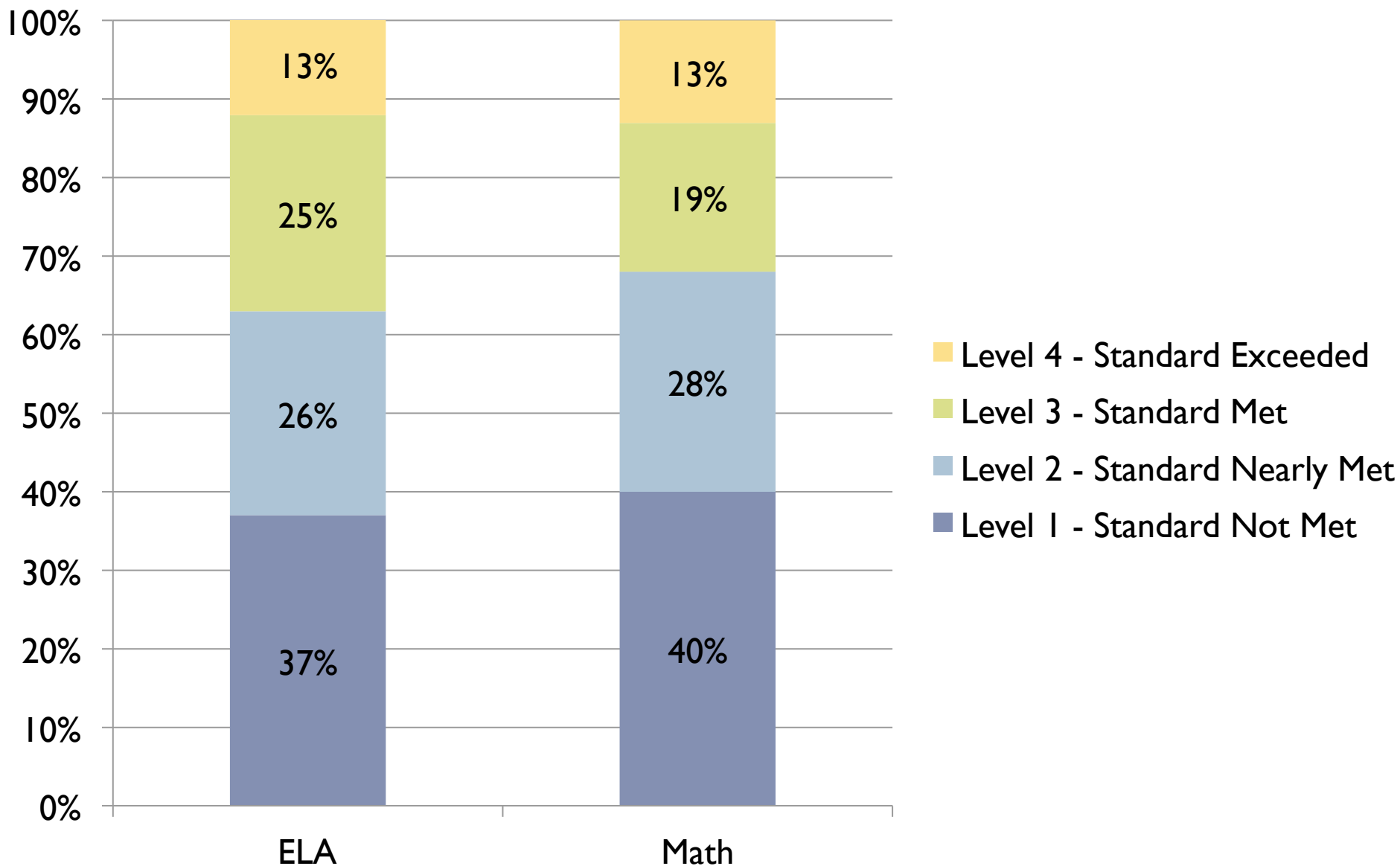

Mathematics (n=5,085)**



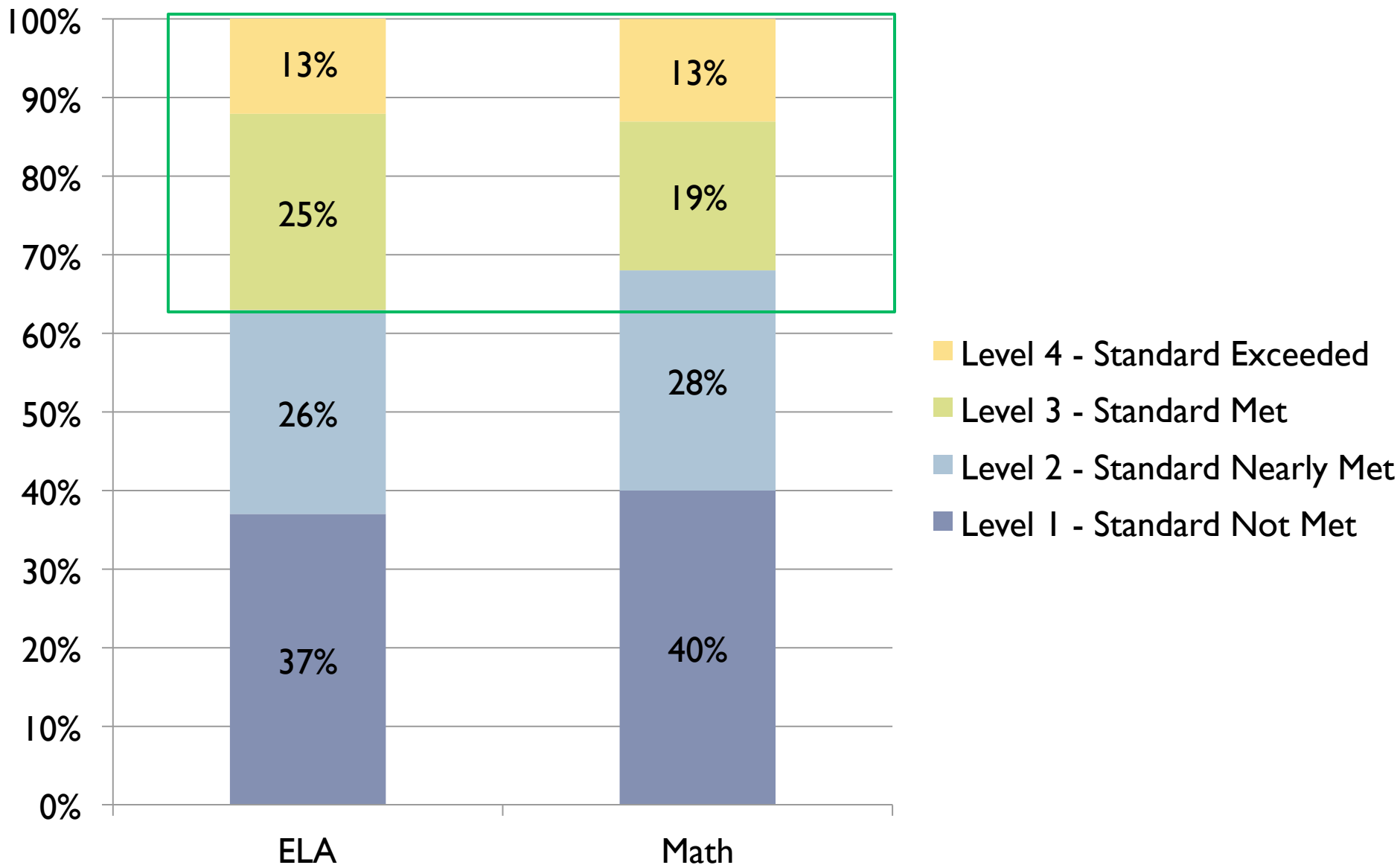
2017 ARUSD Achievement Level Distribution

English Language Arts (n=5,011) and Mathematics (n=5,085)



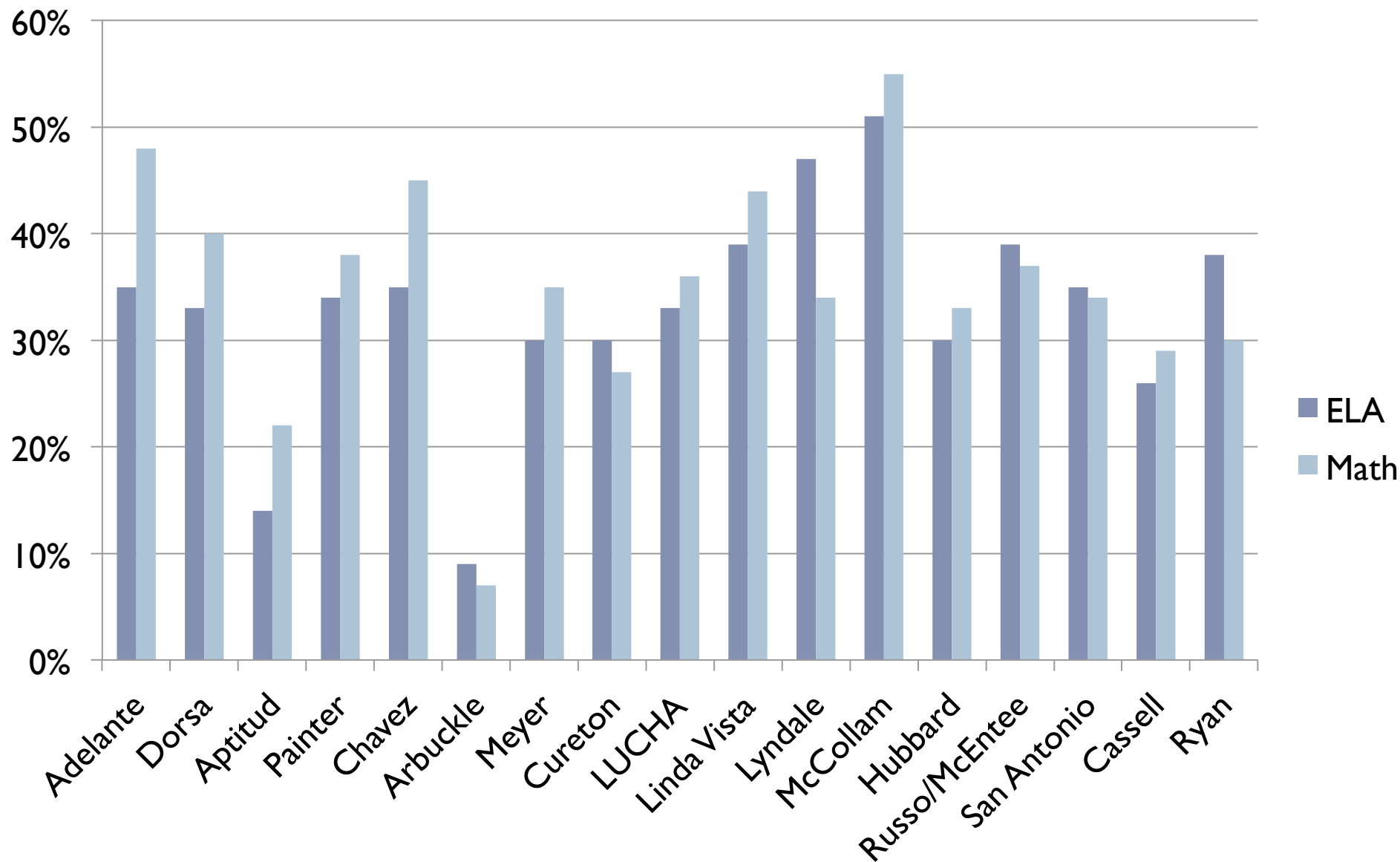

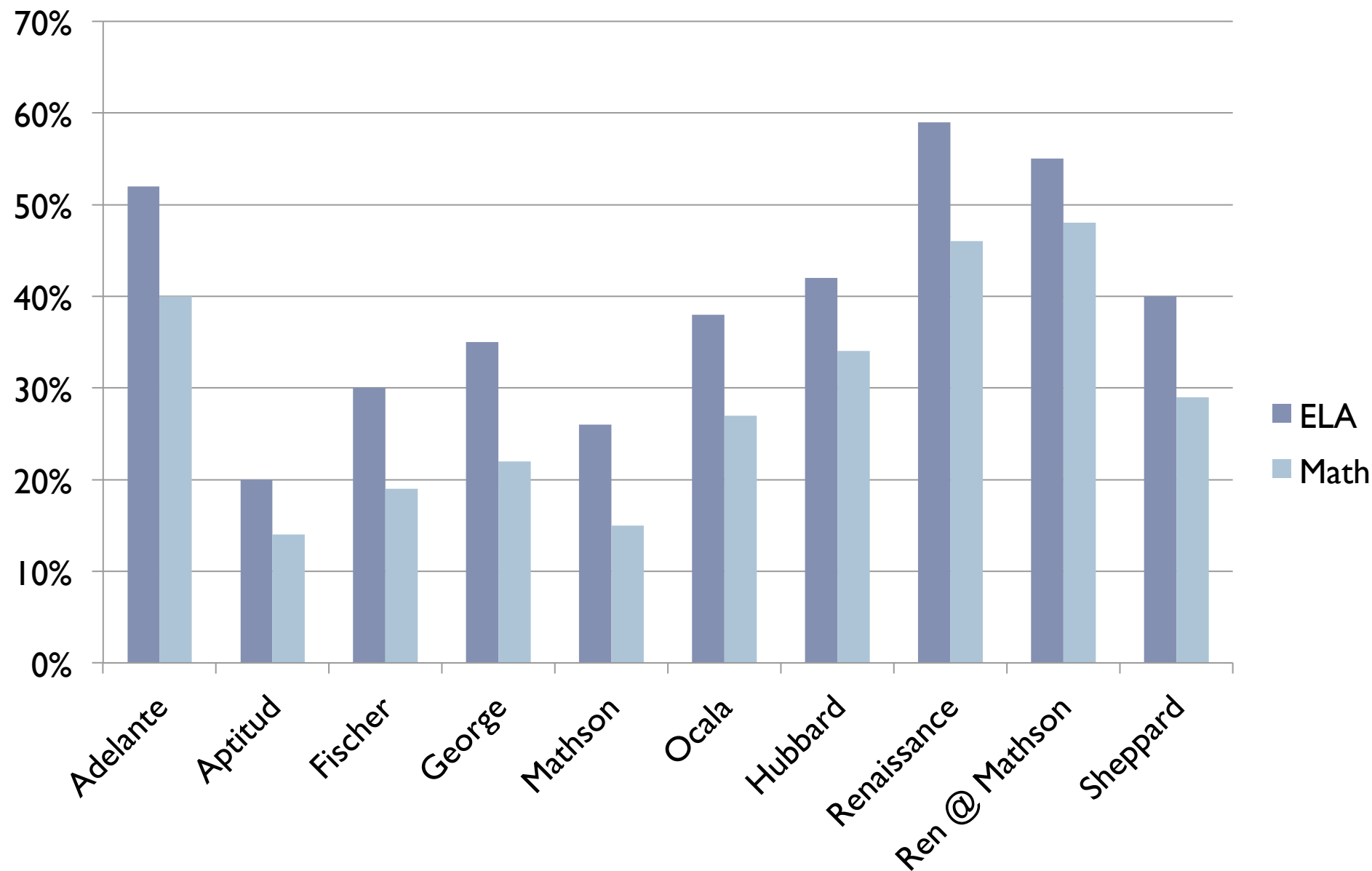

English Language Arts and Mathematics

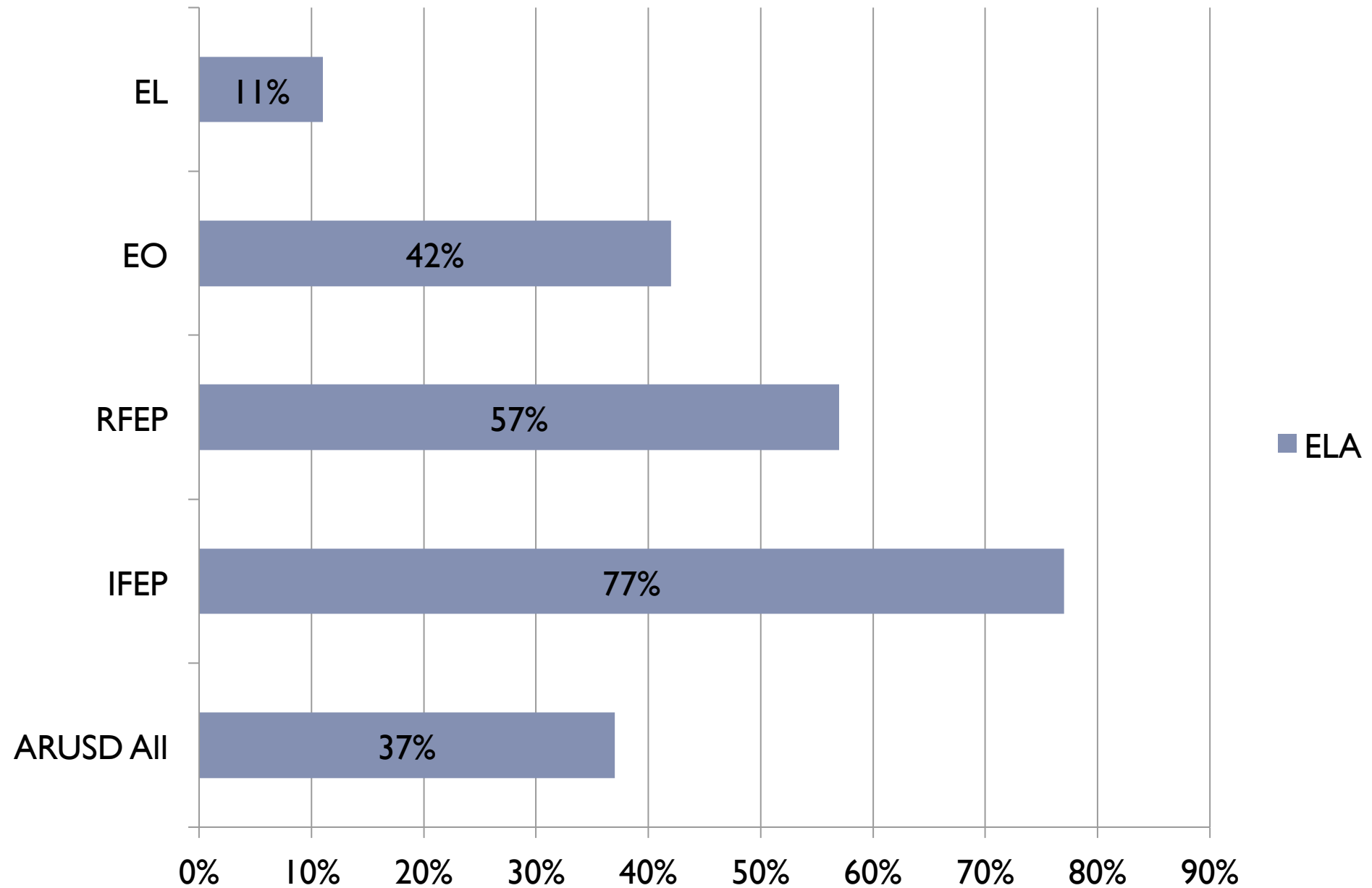




Language Proficiencies

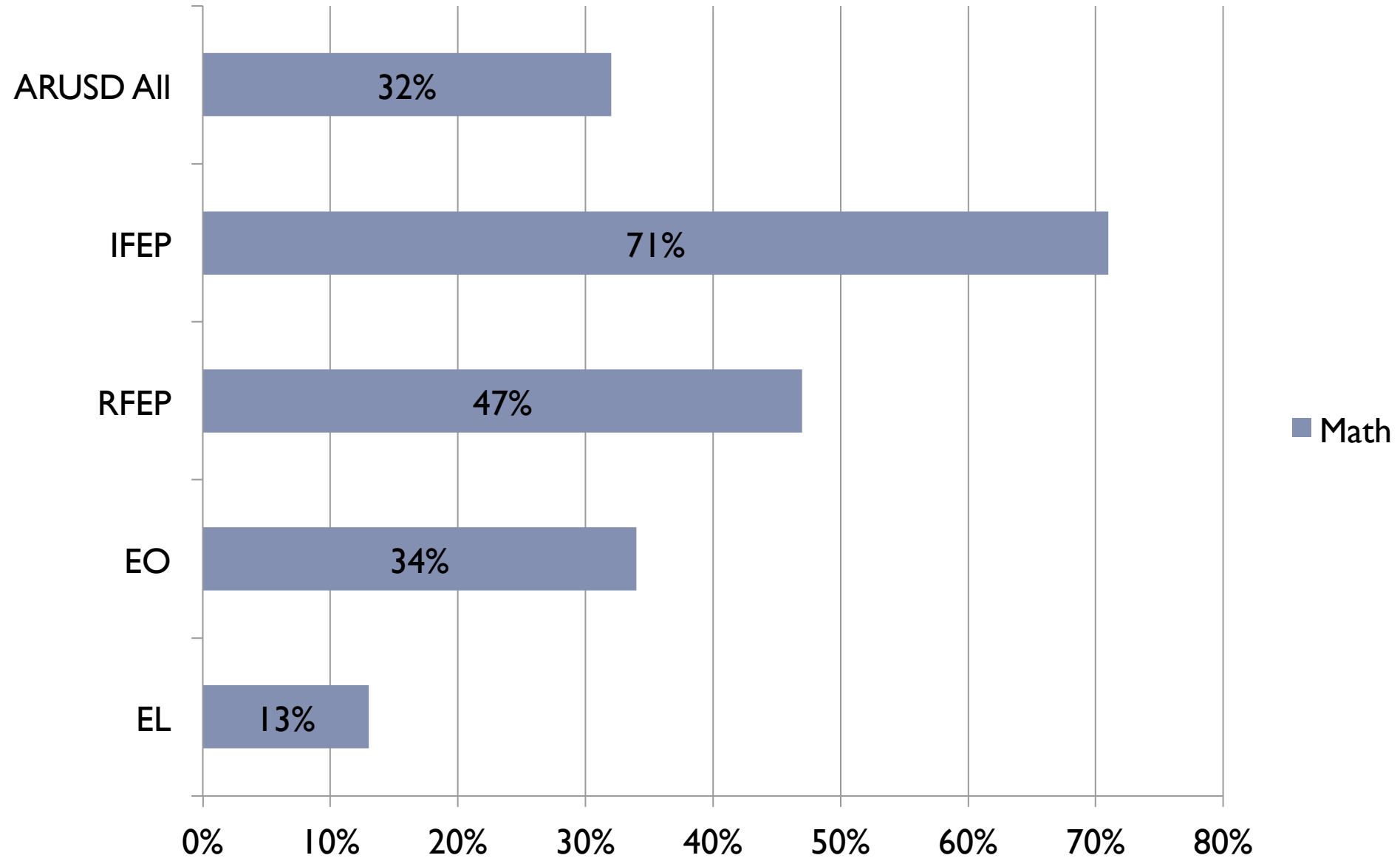
2017 ARUSD Language Proficiencies

Percent Met and Exceeded Mathematics

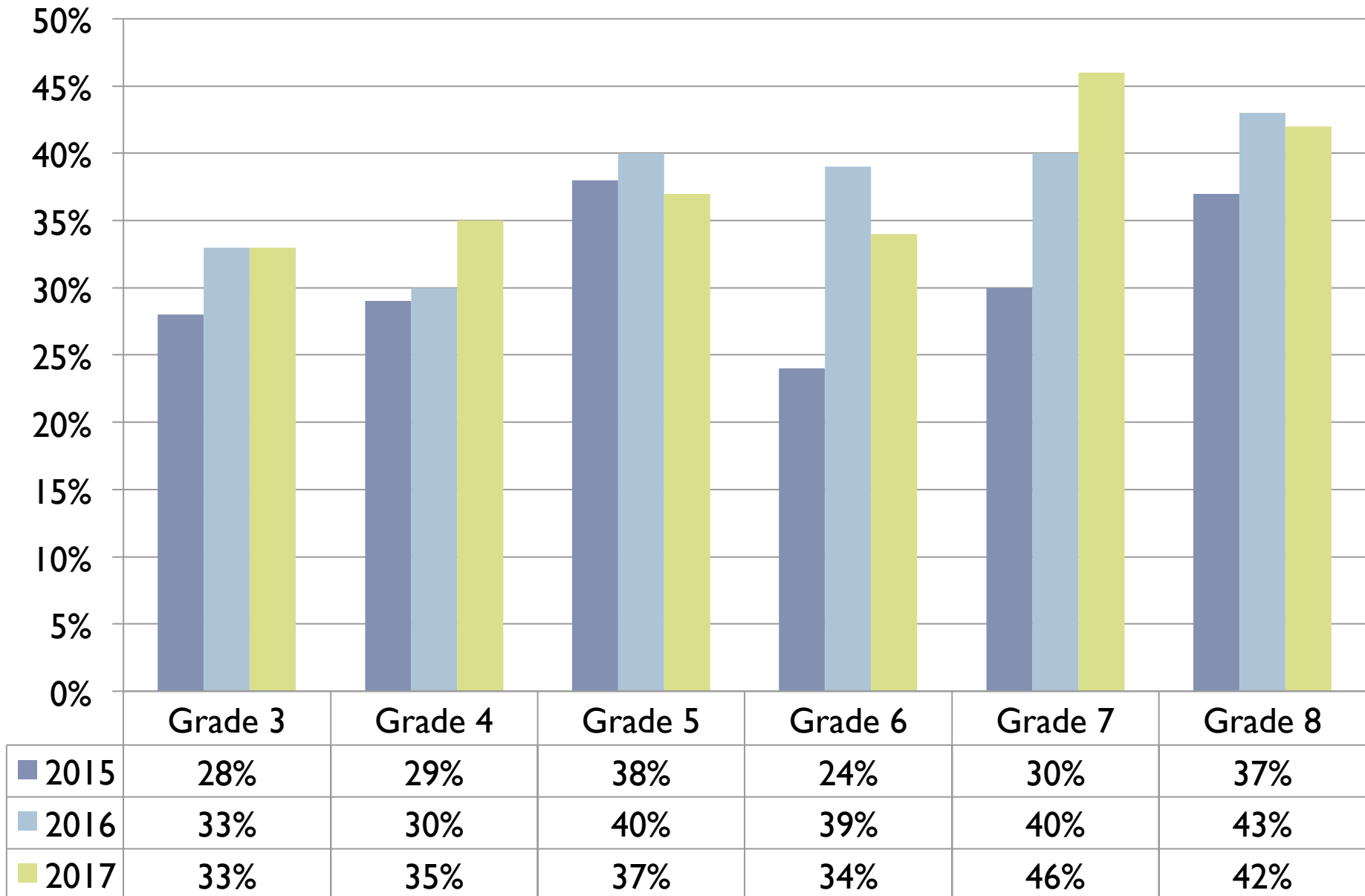




Grade Level Comparison

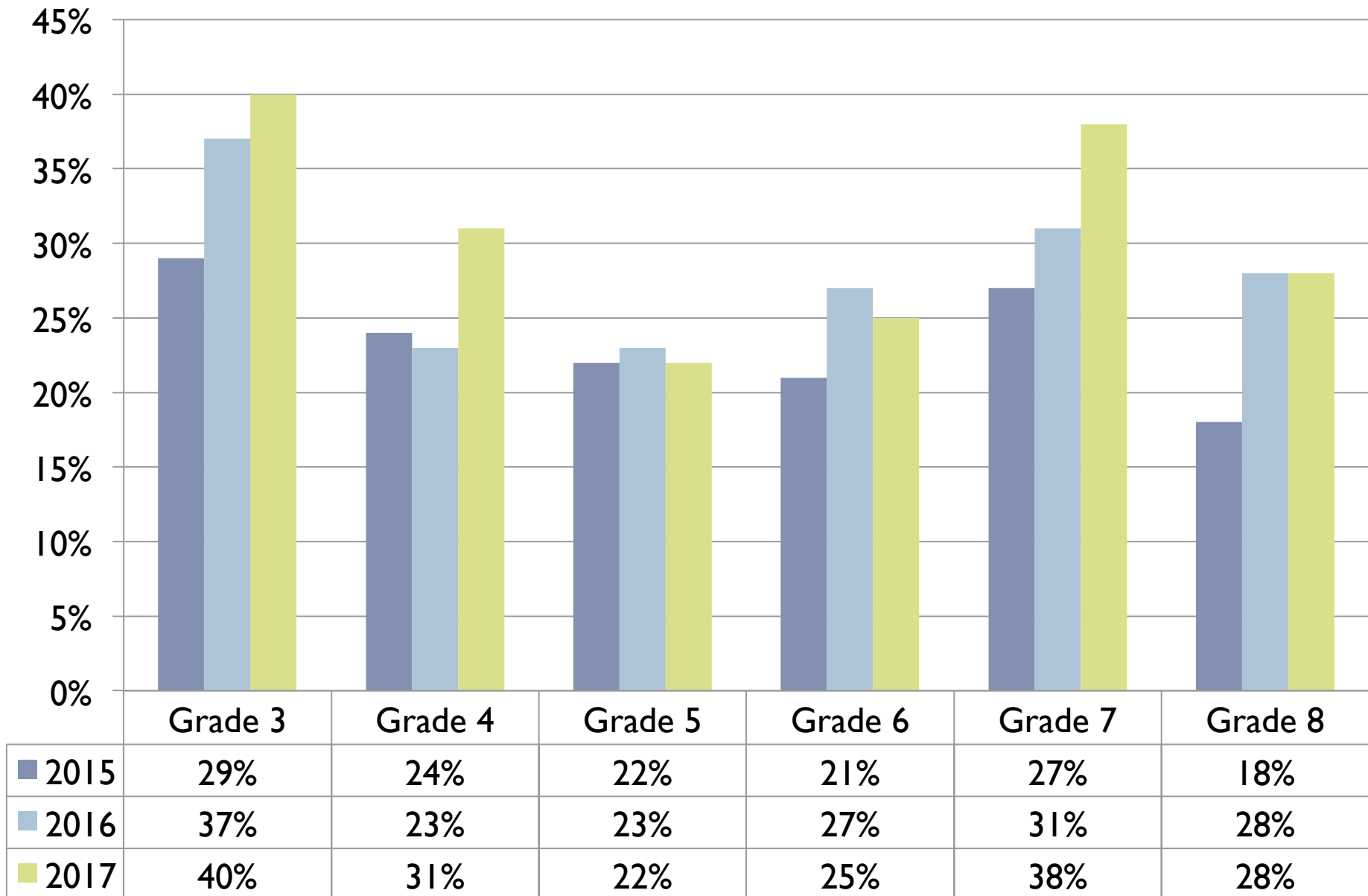
