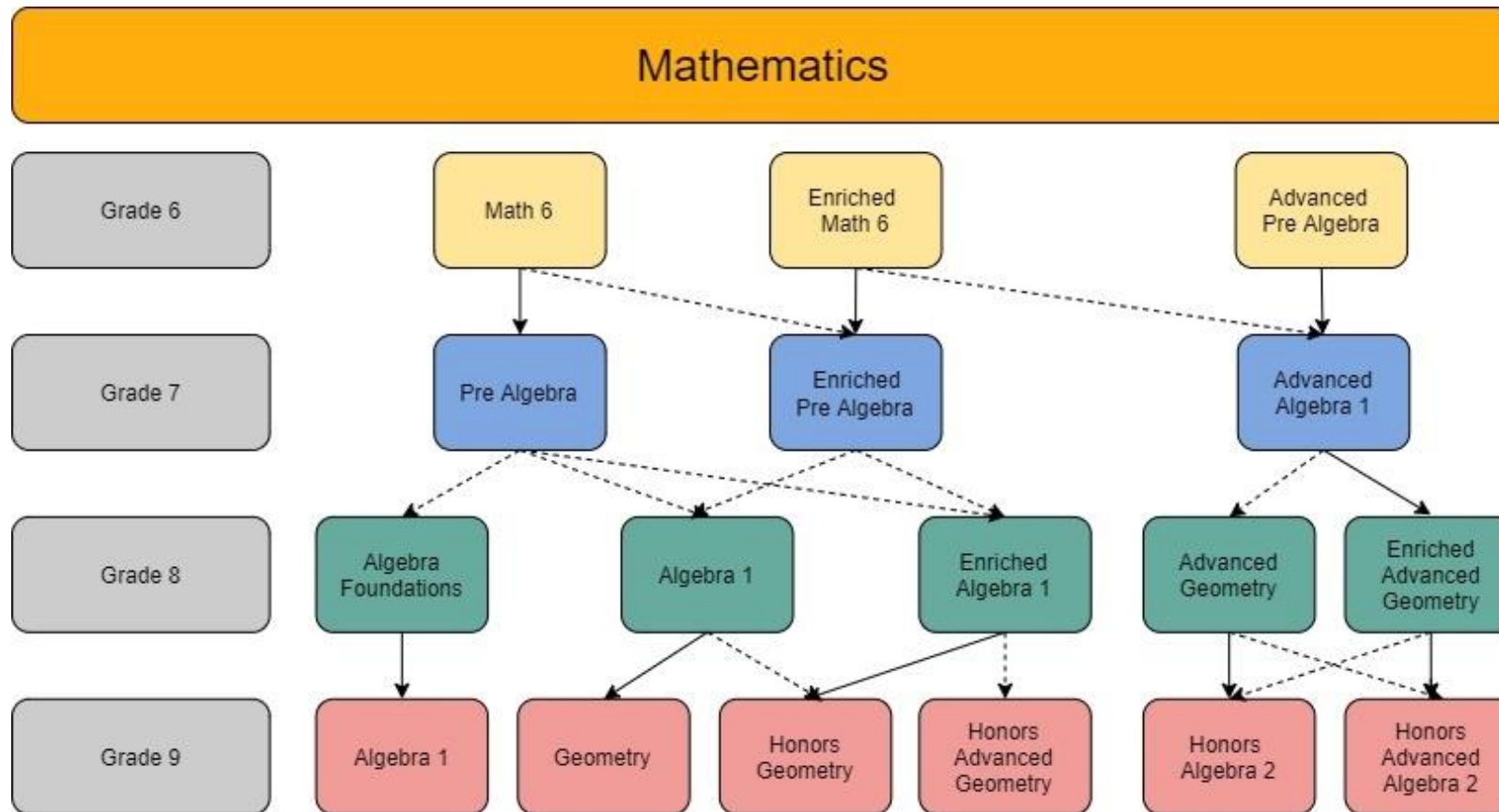


Middle School Mathematics Program Course Pathways



- ❑ To meet the learning needs and interests of its students, the middle school provides three pathways in its mathematics program: regular, enriched, and advanced.
- ❑ In general, enriched refers to extensions in depth and content beyond the regular course of study while advanced further includes a year's acceleration in a student's grade-level math standards.
- ❑ Solid arrows indicate a student's anticipated math pathway from one course to the next course of the same difficulty level.
- ❑ Dashed arrows in grades 6 through 9 indicate a student's possible movement between different courses based on teacher recommendations.
