
That evening at approximately 6:15 (more details on exact times as we get a little closer) your “world premiere” of your graduation ceremonies video will be shown on Channel 8, Facebook Live, and on the ECPPS web Live Stream for all the world to see. At the end of the video, you will hear a message from Mrs. Cobb encouraging you and your family members to jump in your decorated beautiful car (one car per graduate) and meet in the **Central Elementary School Parking lot**. The Final Ride begins there for you and those in your car.

You will be asked upon arrival to tune your radio stations to WRVS 89.9 who will be broadcasting especially for our seniors from 8:30 - 9:30 that evening.

One additional car in your family will have a ticket to park along the parade route to watch! They will have a specific lot on the campus to park in. The ticket will come to you in the mail approximately next Wednesday or Thursday and look something like this:



Other than lining up in the parking lot of Central Elementary school, this entire event will take place on the campus of NHS. The parade will move in one direction in single file from the baseball/ softball fields, behind the AG building, by the Band room, through the bus parking lot, in through the main entrance, and in a loop around the student parking lot. Lots of happiness and memories will hopefully be a part of your ride. I have attached a map of the route and the lots so you can see what it will look like.



At the end of the parade, students will exit the parking lot turning right to go to the dirt road that leads to the practice football field (just like you would to park for football games.) Volunteers will help you park. The NHS Administrators will be waiting for you!! Once the last person goes through the Final Ride, Mrs. Cobb will climb on top of the drum major bandstand where you will all get to be declared "NHS GRADS" and turn your tassels together as one...(in your cars of course because we have to be safe.) A special surprise will end the evening.

Some things to take into consideration:

- There will be no restroom access or refreshments during the Final Ride.
- Only passenger cars, passenger trucks, SUVs and family vans will be allowed. No one will be able to ride in the backs of trucks.
- Everyone must remain in their cars. Should individuals not comply with remaining in their cars, they will be asked to leave the premises by law enforcement and not be allowed to continue to participate in the remainder of the activities for the night.

- ONLY 1 car per graduate will be allowed through the Final Ride route. One additional car ticket will be allowed to park along the Final Ride Route and observe the Final Ride..
- Families are encouraged to decorate vehicles for the Final Ride parade. Decorating should be completed before arrival on campus.
- Law enforcement/ NHS staff will be located at all entrances to the NHS campus and CES campus to check for appropriate vehicle entry and direct traffic. Officers will also be strategically placed throughout the campus to make sure regulations in place are followed before, during and after the Final Ride
