

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What do we need to know about my passport/carnet (RUT)?

Most importantly, this is the ID number that will be used to arrange any travel logistics associated with your WWW program this year. Please be sure to submit the correct information. Non-Chilean students who hope to travel outside of Chile should travel with a passport, valid six months after the date of the WWW travel. Students under age 18 will also need to obtain a notarized permission to travel outside Chile without their parents/guardians. For any students who plan on staying in Chile for WWW this year, the Chilean RUT number is sufficient.

Who will book my flight?

All flights and other travel logistics will be arranged by Nido and/or the corresponding WWW program providers.

Will someone help me obtain my visa?

It is the family's responsibility to research if a visa is required for travel to the location of the WWW program, based on the nationality of the student, and obtain said visa.

Will I have to get immunizations in order to travel?

Depending upon the location of the WWW program, the family should consult with a physician and/or the Center for Disease Control website to make your family's decision about some vaccines. If any vaccines are absolutely required, the WWW program providers will share this info and it is the family's responsibility to follow these requirements.

***Please remember students will NOT be placed in a program until we have the signed authorization document, which should be delivered to school. Without this document, the WWW registration is INCOMPLETE.**

Can I change trips once I've registered?

Once the WWW program assignment is published, the students will have one week to request changes with a parental authorization. It is important to note that availability in other WWW programs may not be possible. After this 1 week period, WWW changes are closed. If students want to drop from a WWW program, penalty fees are dependent on the Terms and Conditions of the WWW program providers, available on the WWW section of the Nido website.

Do I have to participate in WWW?

WWW is part of our curricular program at Nido. All students are expected to participate. There is a wide range of different programs, both travel and local, to match a variety of interests or needs. Families of students who do not complete the WWW registration will be contacted by the HS office to complete this task.

What if my child gets sick or injured or we have some other family conflict that prevents my child/ren from attending WWW?

As has been stated before, **any withdrawals from WWW after the published 'Change Request period' are subject to the terms and conditions from each WWW provider**, available in the details for each program on the WWW section of the Nido website. **Parents may prefer to research and purchase a Travel Insurance policy to have some coverage should an unexpected event/conflict occur.**

Why isn't the WWW program included in tuition?

The WWW program has selected programs with a broad range of appeal to best match students interest and passions. As a result, the costs of the programs vary widely. Keeping the cost separate from tuition allows families to pay the specific and individualized costs of the trips they choose. **WWW charges will be issued on students' accounts for the month when WWW occurs.**
