SCREENING POLICY

All bags and persons are subject to a visual and metal detector screening. Screening are a condition of entry and any refusal to be inspected may result in a refusal to admit. HEB Park encourages guests to NOT bring bags to the Park. If a guest chooses to bring a bag to the Arena, they must be clear and no larger than 12"x 12"x 6".

PROHIBITED

- Aerosol cans: air horns, sunscreens, bug spray, silly string, hairspray.
- All and any Tobacco products (chewing, tobacco, cigarettes etc.)
- Animals, with the exception of service animals
- Baby seats or carriers (unless ticket is purchased for it)
- Banners, signs and/or flags larger than 2 feet tall by 2 feet wide. Any banners or signs that do not fit this guideline may submit a request for entry in writing to Guest Services guestservices@bertogdenarena.com
- Beach balls, inflated Balloons/Objects and Frisbees
