This hunt challenges language skills. To challenge articulation skills, have your child think of words that contain their target sound. For fluency, have your child use smooth speech to talk about the words.

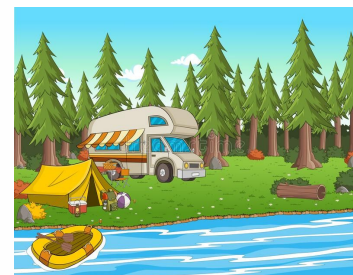
