

## GETTING READY FOR 2ND GRADE! WORD STUDY





This year in 1st Grade students focused on the following areas for word study:


- -Letter-sound patterns for short and long vowels, blends and digraphs
- -Snap/No excuse words
- -Phonological awareness (PA) skills breaking and blending words into sounds and syllables
- -Chinese Rainbow Words & Chinese Pinyin (For Dual Language only)


The following choice board provides a sample of activities and games that you might do with your child over the summer to reinforce and review concepts/skills. Practicing these skills and concepts in fun ways will promote engagement. We also recommend giving students <u>choice</u> in what activity or skill they practice. Students are <u>encouraged</u> to revisit any activities they are interested in.


