Important Dates

At Kineton High School, we are committed to building an effective working partnership with families. Please note these important dates for your diary:

Primary School Visits – May/June 2020. Unfortunately, these will not be able to go ahead this year. Please be reassured that Kineton's transition team will be in contact with your child's primary school and we will ensure that all pertinent information is passed on. We are also looking into ways of 'bringing Kineton to you' via our school website under Information and then Transition.

Wednesday 8th July - Induction Day. We are hoping that this can go ahead as planned. This is an exciting day when new students will spend a day here, getting to know the school, the people in it and experiencing what life in our school is like. An overview of Induction Day can be found in the Student Guide. Please try to ensure that your child is able to attend and comes equipped with a pen, pencil and packed lunch. Students are to wear their normal primary school uniform on this day. It is possible for students to use our school bus service (if a bus route currently serves your area) for the Induction Day if they wish to; this is free of charge to students. Bus passes and timetables will be distributed to primary schools closer to the time.

Reserve Day – If the July Induction Day is unable to go ahead, we are hoping to have an Induction Day at the very beginning of September before the rest of the school returns. If this is the case, we will contact you and information will be on the website under the Transition section.

Tuesday 14th July – New Parents and Students meeting at 5.30-6:30pm. You will have the opportunity to meet members of staff who will play a significant role during your child's first year here. Please complete the attached slip and return it to Ms S Kite as soon as possible, but no later than Monday 10th June.

Reserve Option – This will be dependant upon Government guidance at the time but a possibility is that the meeting will be split into two sessions depending upon which House your child is in: Adlington and Ainslie 5.00 - 5.45pm Hoy and Redgrave 6.00 - 6.45pm.
