To Novi Community School District Parents and Community Members:

We are planning to hold in-person summer school starting July 6. We are delaying the start of summer school so that we can have an in-person experience for our students. By delaying to July 6 we will be able to welcome students and teachers to Novi High School.

As a result of delaying summer summer school to July 6, the summer school semester will be July 6 - July 31.

We have worked very hard to ensure that we maintain a safe learning environment that adheres to appropriate CDC guidelines and the Governor's executive orders.

First, we have identified areas within the high school to hold classes maximizing space and ensuring that students are separated into three main non connecting areas.

Second, we will be implementing staggered start and end times to reduce the number of students entering the building at one time.

Third, we will have three separate entrances into the building divided by class subject.

At this point, masks will be worn by all summer school staff. Students will be given a mask to use for the program. We are currently required to monitor temperatures and symptom checklists will be required each day. Students and staff with temperatures above recommended will not be able to enter the building.

Finally, students will be receiving information via email regarding what time to arrive, what entrance to use when attending summer school and what room number the class will be located and what time they will be dismissed prior to July 6, 2020.
