We would like to invite all Year 12 students to a careers event run by UCAS at the University of Worcester on Thursday 19th March 2020. All major University and Apprenticeship providers will be represented at the event and it will give students the opportunity to talk to them and consider their future choices, complimenting the workshops and discussions that students will be having at school.

This is a free event but to cover cost of transport by coach we are asking for a contribution of £5 per student payable via parent pay by Friday 10th January. The preferred method of payment is via Parentpay. If you face financial difficulty in meeting this cost we may be able to offer assistance. Please write in confidence to the Headteacher.

The coach will depart from school at 9.00am and will return at approximately 2.30pm depending on traffic. If students miss the main bus service at 2.45pm they will be able to access the late bus service at 4pm.

There may be an opportunity to purchase refreshments at the event however this cannot be guaranteed so we recommend that students bring something to eat and a drink throughout the day. It is advisable that students do not take valuables on this trip. However, if it is necessary, please ensure that your own insurance covers such items.
