Dear Parent/Carer

This year our annual Charity Week, where the Sixth Form students raise money for their chosen charities, will take place the week beginning Monday 16th December 2019. Over the past 5 years Sixth Form students have raised in excess of £20,000 for charities and we hope to continue to support those who need it.

Sixth Form students are raising money this year for 'Asthma UK' and 'Mind' by running a break time tuck shop, hosting lunchtime events featuring their subject teachers and performing a pantomime style show on the final day of term.

Students who wish to purchase snacks from the break time tuck shop, and attend the lunchtime events (50p entry), will need to bring a small amount of cash with them each day. The number of students attending each event will be limited and will be first come first served, to protect the health and safety of all students. Please note, events cannot be paid for in advance.

During the last day of term Sixth Form students will be performing their annual Charity Show, written and directed by students themselves; it aims to entertain the student body whilst raising money for the chosen charities. We are asking for a donation of £3.50 from each student who wishes to watch the Charity Show, this will be collected during morning registration, from tomorrow (by Sixth Form students). An alternative activity will be arranged for those who do not wish to watch the Charity Show. The day will be non-uniform with the theme of 'Wear Your Christmas Jumper', students will need to pay a £1 donation, which is included in the £3.50 donation if watching the show.

Sixth Form students will also be performing the Charity Show on Tuesday 17th December 2019 at 7pm in the main school hall, for any parents/carers or members of the community who wish to watch the show. We ask for donations to the chosen charities on the door, a suggested donation for entry is £5. Refreshments will also be available during the evening.

We look forward to entertaining the school community and hope to raise as much money as possible for our two chosen charities.
