


ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
BAKER UNIVERSITY - SCHOOL OF PROFESSIONAL AND GRADUATE STUDIES (SPGS)
AND
ALLEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This articulation agreement is made between Baker University-School of Professional and Graduate Studies and Allen Community College. By entering this agreement, Baker University-SPGS and Allen Community College express a mutual commitment to increasing opportunities and access to higher education for adult students.

This agreement provides adult working professionals from Allen Community College an opportunity to seamlessly transfer into baccalaureate programs at Baker University-SPGS. Per this agreement, students who graduate from Allen Community College with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have met the general education requirements in the Baker University School of Professional and Graduate Studies baccalaureate programs and will be granted admission, provided they meet all admission criteria. Admission will be limited to program availability and openings and this agreement will be reviewed prior to the beginning of each academic year.


