## Welcome to Summer Adventure Club

Adventure Club is the School Age Child Care Program of Robbinsdale Area Schools. There are several convenient locations within district schools for students entering Kindergarten through fifth grade beginning at 6:30 am and running until 6 pm.

Adventure Club is staffed by trained professionals who have a combination of education and experience especially suited to working with school aged children. With curriculum designed to enhance learning, students are encouraged to make choices, practice decision making skills and build positive peer relationships.

Summer Adventure Club runs from **Tues, Jun 9- Fri, Aug 21 (closed July 3)** from 6:30 am-6 pm.

### AGES

Adventure Club is for students entering kindergarten through fifth grade. Students outside of the school district or from private schools are welcome to enroll in Adventure Club.

### ACTIVITIES

Our program offers extracurricular activities which are designed to promote physical activity, build positive social relationships and foster teamwork. Daily activities include gym games, science experiments, cooking projects, social recreation and art.
