Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Longview School District requires any student who volunteers in a school other than the one he/she attends to fill out a volunteer registration packet. This registration packet is the same one that all adult volunteers must complete.

The packet, in addition to requesting some routine personal information, includes a sheet that asks volunteer applicants to tell us if they have been convicted of any serious crime. It also asks for information for a Washington State Patrol Criminal History request. Inclusion of the social security number on the Washington State Patrol form is optional.

We have students complete the registration packet because the possibility exists that a young person with a criminal history might seek a volunteer position at an unsuspecting school. We want to do everything possible to keep all of our students safe.

For students who are under the age of 18, we ask their parents to grant permission for this volunteer screening process by completing the form below and returning it with the volunteer sign-up packet.

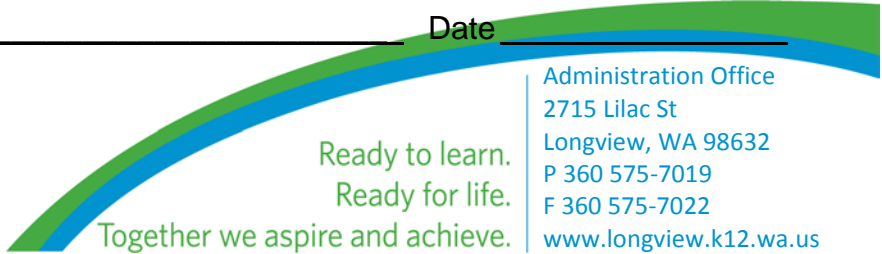
