1. Read the short story <u>"A Temporary Matter" by Jhumpa Lahiri</u>.

When you are reading, consider two main elements:

- the role of the **'unspoken'** in the story
- the **themes** that the story explores Reminder: a theme is a universal message, idea or lesson that a piece of literature explores or presents. It differs from plot.
- 2. **Write down** your thoughts about these two important elements. Consider the role that the 'unspoken' has played in your own life. Be ready to discuss further when we meet in August.
