Protests for 12 days and continuing...

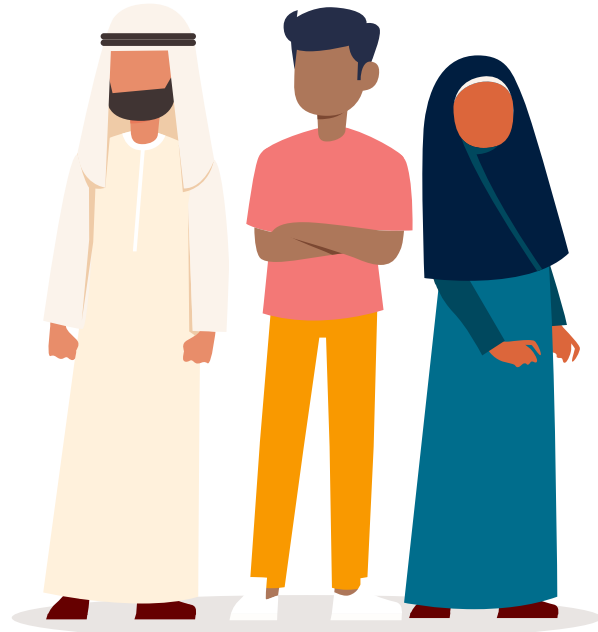
