#### Phased re-opening update

Firstly, I would like to thank parents and carers for the warm messages of support and positive feedback we have received this week. It has been an absolute joy to welcome back more children from Reception and Year 1 to the academy. Thank you to all parents for adhering to the guidance sent and we look forward to welcoming more children back next week.

<u>Collection and Drop offs</u>: To support parents and carers in arriving earlier than the allocated drop off and collection times (thank you for your promptness) we will be opening the doors to your child's allocated bubble 5 minutes before the allocated time provided. This is in an attempt to reduce any significant queueing. If you are running late, please could you kindly inform the academy office via phone (01293 873975) or email (office@phiacademy.org.uk).

**For children yet to return:** We continue to require a minimum of 2 working days notice if you wish your child to return to the academy. However, please note that you will need to await confirmation from the academy as to the bubble your child will be allocated to and dependent on staffing capacity. Please do not arrive at the academy without confirmation of your child's bubble. Suggested home learning activities will remain available—please see below for further details.

**Important notice:** If for any reason any of the above is no longer possible, even if it appears possible, or it's been possible in another school in the local area, then please trust that we have not taken the decision likely. We continue to review these measures and while every effort has been made to minimise the impact to you and your child, there may come a time where necessary changes will need to be made at short notice. Thank you for your continued support and understanding.

Suggested Home Learning activity sheets and timetables will continue to be structured in the new format.

Activities will continue to focus on topics that the children would normally be covering in the academy. You will continue to receive suggested activity grids at the start of each week. This builds towards a topic that your child will be working on over the whole term.

Although each year group will be working on a different topic, we will continue to provide suggested timetables, so that there are opportunities for children in all year groups to be able to take part in learning for the same/ similar subject at the same time, whilst they remain at home.
