Dear Parents and Carers,

We wanted to start this letter to you by acknowledging what a challenging time this has been for all our families at Sydenham, for the staff and for our students.

Thank you so much to all our families for supporting your children with their learning at home. You have had to support your children with remote learning as well as manage the multiple needs of your own work, home and other children or family that you may have to care for. We are aware that some of you are also doing this whilst suffering from illness or loss within your own family or/and struggling due to financial hardship.

The priority of the school and us as Governors at lockdown was to ensure that all our students had a home learning provision alongside the ability to access remote learning and we continue to work with the Senior Leadership Team to focus on this.

This is of course an apt moment in this letter to thank school staff for providing home learning resources. Many of them have also had to create a home learning environment for their own children.

We would also like to extend our thanks to the PTA for their extraordinary work and time given in fundraising over £11,000 for students who need access to technology and data.
