By completing an agreed upon sequence of classes in general education and a selected major with a stated minimum GPA, you can apply to the four-year institution within a prescribed time-frame and be "guaranteed admission."

# California Assessments of Student Performance and Progress

## CAASPP Testing: April 6th-10th and April 13th-17th

Each spring, all grade eleven students in California take the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments for English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics administered as part of the CAASPP system.

Taking these assessments in their Junior year gives students the opportunity to strengthen their skills during their Senior year by enrolling in the appropriate courses.

Students who authorize the release of their CAASPP results for each assessment to the Community College and California State University (CSU) systems may have them evaluated along with other measures for general education course placement for Freshmen applicants.

Results are only used to determine a student's CSU placement after the student has been admitted. The release of the CAASPP results will not affect a student's application for admission.
