

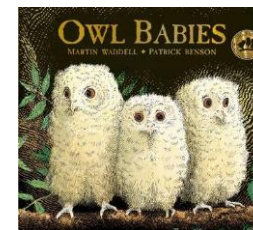


YEAR 2 WEEKLY HOME LEARNING – W/C 15.6.20
