Arts & Innovation: Our Vision

The quality and ambition of our program is not matched by its current spaces. Our new 2,500 square foot Arts & Innovation Lab will allow students to explore the powerful connection between innovation and creativity and allow for shared tools and materials across spaces.

Additional space also allows for more experience with heavier, messier tools such as table saws and welders. In side by side studios, students can collaborate integrating more traditional art materials with 3-D printers and laser cutters. On the third floor, a robotics lab for students to explore coding, robotics, and to practice problem-solving skills.
