Parents Urged to Make Appointments Now for Back-to-School Immunizations

JACKSON, Miss. – Today the Mississippi State Department of Health (MSDH) is urging parents to act now and schedule their child's age-appropriate immunizations before summer is over. Mississippi state law requires children to be immunized against childhood diseases to enter public or private school, Head Start or daycare.

Make an appointment at your county health department clinic to bring your child in for their immunizations. A list of county health department locations along with times and days the clinics are open can be found at <u>www.HealthyMS.com/locations</u>.

Parents should bring the child's social security card and insurance card if available. Parents and children over 2 must wear a mask when entering the county health department clinic.
