**Flyleaf Publishing** This link is to the Student Page. Flyleaf will be free through the 2020-21 school year. Our tutors use Flyleaf's titles because they contain controlled vocabulary in robust and beautifully illustrated stories.

**American Literature** Lots of traditional and historic literature to choose from, although your child may find the reading levels a challenge. The tabs that yield the most good reads are *Children* and *Features*.

**International Reading Association reading lists** Published annually. Children's and teachers' choices, YA choices, award winners. Extensive selection.

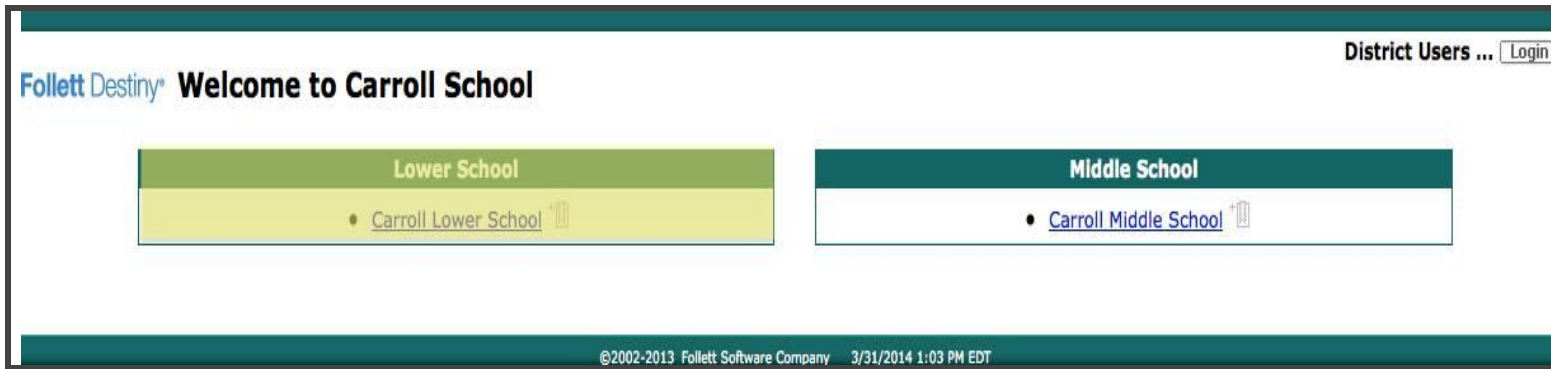
**Multnomah County Library book lists** Thematic lists of good read-alouds and books for kids to read independently by grade level.

**Reading Rockets** Book advisory lists, advice for struggling readers that parents will find helpful.

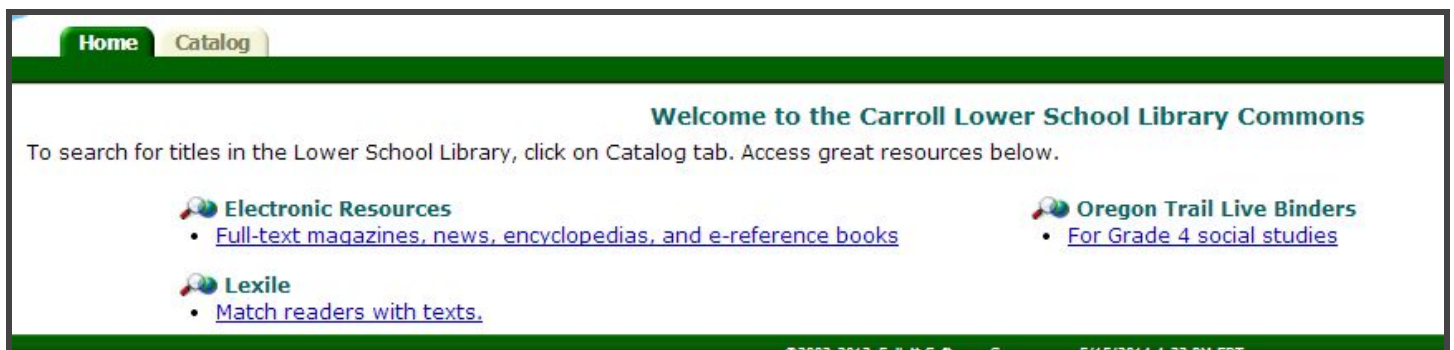
**Series & Sequels** Look up kids' series by title or subject, or by book's title or author in this database of 4,900 series titles.

# Using Destiny to find Lexile and Fountas & Pinnell levels of trade books in the Lower School Library

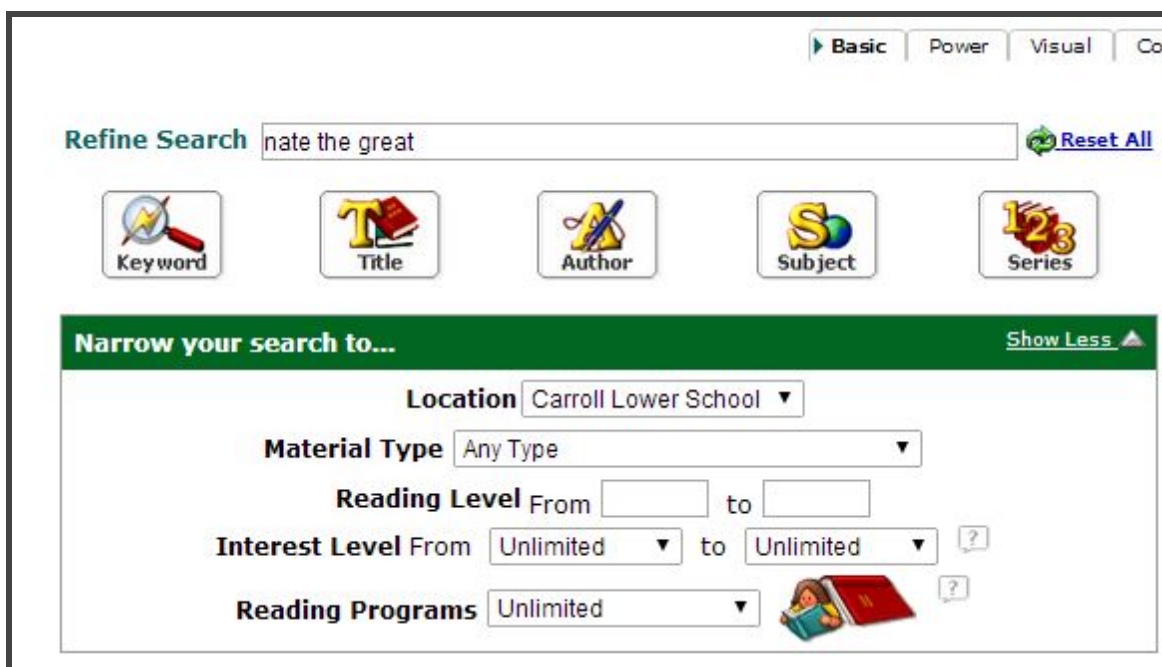
1. Go to the Destiny website: <https://carrollschool.follettdestiny.com>. Select Lower School.



2. On the Lower School Home page, select the Catalog tab.



3. In the Catalog's Find box, type the title or subject of a book. The example below is for Nate the Great. Notice that "Reading Programs" is set to Unlimited.



4. If a title has a level assigned for either Lexile or Fountas & Pinnell, it will be listed in the Search Results page, as shown below.
