

Homeschool Graduation Track Requirements

Students petitioning to graduate from a Lakeland Joint School District High School upon transferring into one of the district's high schools after attending a non-accredited school, must be a full-time student at the school their senior year and submit a portfolio of work. All district graduation credit requirements must be met prior to graduation.

Parents/guardians of students who complete classes from non-accredited schools must submit a portfolio with the following components to be considered for a graduation track at Lakeland High School, Timberlake High School, and Mountain View Alternative School.

1. Course Title and Description
2. Syllabus
3. Textbook or course materials (will be returned to parent after review)
4. Key samples of work and description of all work completed
5. End of course assessments for each class
5. Log of total number of hours worked on the class
6. Final Grade

Once the portfolio has been submitted, the building principal will review the information with a curriculum review committee. The parent will be notified in a timely fashion as to the decision of the school to grant or deny credit for graduation. If the credit is approved, it will be posted as a "P" (Pass) grade on the transcript. Students who transfer under these criteria will not be eligible for valedictorian or salutatorian recognition. If determined necessary to grant credit, the student may be required to take a district approved diagnostic test in that subject in order to determine successful completion.
