



ADDITIONAL VETERAN'S BENEFITS

INCOME BASED PROGRAMS

Application Period is February 1 through October 1, 2020

Local Additional Exemption: The West Hartford Town Council adopted a local ordinance providing increased income limits for an additional exemption. The income limits are \$70,100 for a married couple and \$62,000 for a single person. The exemption is an assessment reduction of \$10,000 or 10% of assessed value, whichever is greater.

State Additional Exemption: The maximum income allowed for a married couple is \$45,100 and the maximum income for a single person is \$37,000.

Veterans with 100 percent disability rating and an adjusted gross income of less than \$21,000 for a married couple and \$18,000 for a single person are also eligible to apply for these benefits.

Income requirements: To determine if you meet the income limits, add your adjusted gross income (less, taxable Social Security) from the 2019 Federal Income Tax filing to the amount you received from Social Security for the calendar year 2019. Married couples must include income for both persons. If you did not file an income tax return for 2019, you must provide copies of all your 1099 forms from all sources of income.

Public Act 06-153 Veteran's disability payments do not count as income for these programs.

To apply, please bring copies of your 2019 Income Tax Return and your 2019 Social Security Form 1099(s) to our office. We are located in the Assessment Office, Town Hall, 50 South Main Street, Room 142. Our office hours are 8:30am to 4:30pm on Mondays and Wednesdays, 7:30am - 4:30pm on Tuesdays, and 8:30am -7:00pm on Thursdays. The deadline to apply for these programs is October 1, 2020.
