- Add Bethel as grade recipient.
- Pay CLEP Fee. (This does not include test center fee; see below.)
- Print out CLEP Exam Registration Ticket.

RESULTS: You will receive results before you leave.

- The registrar's office receives an official transcript within 2-3 weeks.
- The registrar will evaluate results and grant credit as warranted. Notice of credit received will be sent to you.
