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Introduction

I am delighted to be able to have you back in school. It has felt a very strange and empty place since that Friday in March when we closed the doors to 'normal school'.

We need you here to make it a school ... without young people it is a big empty building!

This booklet is designed to explain how the last 4 weeks of this term will work. It tells you

- What days you will be in
- What times you will be in
- What you will be doing
- How you should behave
- How you should keep safe

You probably know that the government told us that we could only have 25% of the year group in on any day. That has made creating a timetable quite a challenge! We are also only able to use the teachers who are available – some have to stay at home still following the government guidance and some have to stay at home to look after their own children or family relatives.

These factors have led us to create a schedule which means that you will all get 2 hours of support from subject teachers (not always your normal teacher). These sessions will be aimed at reviewing the key points from the work that you were given during the lockdown.

Now on to the details ...

Arrival to and departure from school

- **YOU MUST NOT COME TO SCHOOL IF YOU ARE FEELING UNWELL IN ANY WAY**
- The sessions will run from Monday – Friday, generally for the morning only allowing for **a deep clean each afternoon**.
- School uniform should be worn but **not a blazer** and the jumper is **optional**.
- The sessions start at 9.00 am so you should aim to **arrive between 8.40-8.50**
- **You will be using a new entrance – at the back of school – there will be staff guiding you and you should keep to the 2 metre markings on the path if queuing**
- To reduce numbers of students on site:
 - Parents should avoid coming to the school reception. If parents need to do this, please phone and make an appointment in advance.
- Upon entering school, you will be asked to use a hand sanitiser.
- You will collect your 'resource pack' – **you do not need to bring any equipment**
- You will then move to your designated room, seat and table
- At the end of the morning, you will be asked to use the hand sanitiser before leaving the room, head downstairs following the one way system and return your resource pack.

Movement around school

- Some areas of the school will become one-way and will be clearly labelled as such.
 - The Maths corridor will be one-way but in the opposite direction to that you are used to
 - **The middle stairs will be for going up only and the two end stairs will be for going down.**
- If groups of pupils are moving for specialist options lessons (e.g. for Art, lessons etc), you must stay with your teacher at all times

Year 10 learning plan

- The timetable below shows the pattern for this 4 week period
It is really important that you look through it carefully and highlight the days that you should be in school because it is not every day!
- In total, you will be coming to school for **6 days**
- You should be in when:
 - It is your tutor group day for Maths, English & Science – there are 2 of these days – make sure you get the right ones!
 - You will also have to come in for your Options sessions – you will have one day for each of these but you need to look carefully at the **lists** to see which day is your day. Some of the Options have 2 sessions and some 4 so make sure you work out which is your day.
 - If you do business studies, this will be on one of your Tutor group days and you will have a lunch break in school.
 - On the business studies days, you will be offered a sandwich lunch if you would like one, OR you can bring a packed lunch with you. If you bring a packed lunch from home, please make sure you have a bag because you will need to take everything home with you afterwards.
 - There will be no breaktimes but there will be a few minutes when you can stand and stretch if you want to.
 - You will be able to go to the toilet at any point during the sessions so that we avoid queues there. You will be told which toilets you can use and instead of having boys and girls at each end of a floor, it will be boys one side and girls the other.
 - The toilets will be cleaned during the morning
 - We are providing you with your own mini hand sanitizer which must stay with you in your pack and should be used at regular intervals.
 - Each room and toilet area will also have these – **USE THEM!!**
 - Remember that the best protection against the virus is regular and proper hand washing and social distancing.
 - The government have said that masks do not need to be worn in school.
 - There will be no bells

Any student who does not follow the guidelines will be sent home and not be able to access the support.

Actions if a pupil or staff member shows COVID-19 symptoms



Pupil or staff member displays COVID-19 symptoms.



Send home and advise to follow the latest guidance.



If test is negative, return to school and household ends self-isolation.
If test is positive, move to 'confirmed case' scenario.

Actions if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 in a school



Pupil or staff member tests positive for COVID-19.



Individual receives medical advice and/or treatment.
Class or group sent home and told to self-isolate for 14 days.



If other cases are detected within the school, report to PHE who will investigate and advise.
