Important information from President Botzman for students, faculty and staff

Campus Shutdown: At 2:00pm, Governor Wolf extended the COVID-19 shutdown to include the entire state. All available employees are asked to telecommute tomorrow, March 17, 2020. If you have not been instructed by your supervisor to report as usual, do not come to work. The Emergency Preparedness Task Force will provide a plan for moving forward by the end of the week.

Classes: On-line/remote courses will continue as planned. Classes will resume on Wednesday, March 18, 2020.

Clinicals: Clinicals are suspended until further notice.

Registration: Academic advising was scheduled to begin today and registration for fall term was to begin next Wednesday, March 25. With the transition to online classes, we have postponed advising. Advising and registration will take place after Easter. More information will be forthcoming.
