Wider Opening of the School Site

In my email, I set out details and shared a link to a Firefly survey that must be completed by Sunday at 3.00pm at the latest. The survey is a vital part of our planning. Please do contact the school if you are having any technical difficulties.

On site provision for Years 6, 1, Reception and Nursery will continue as per these past few weeks.

Safety on Site

We are all very excited with the prospect of more pupils returning to site. Not only does this include Junior School pupils, but also some of our older pupils as well. As you can appreciate, the site will become busier and busier before the end of term.

As part of our planning to keep the whole of our community safe, I would ask you to pay attention to these reminders:
