

Colored Carnation Experiment (capillary action)



Materials Needed:

1. White Carnation/other white flowers
2. Clear jars/glasses
3. Food coloring
4. Water
5. Scissors

What to do:

Fill jars half way with water. Put in food coloring. Snip the bottom of the flower stems. Place flowers in the jars and observe the changes every day. How many days does it take for the flowers to completely change color?
