

Rainbow in a Jar

Occasionally, we get to see rainbows in the sky. How would you like to make one right in a jar?

Here is what you need:

- ~ a grown-up*
- ~ Honey*
- ~ olive oil*
- ~ dish washing detergent*
- ~ rubbing alcohol*
- ~ water*
- ~ food coloring*
- ~measuring cup*

Here is what you do:

1st layer - Purple. Mix ¼ cup of honey with a drop of red and blue food coloring. Pour into the jar.

2nd layer - Blue - Pour in gently ¼ cup of blue dish washing detergent. Tilt the jar and pour carefully against the side of the jar so it pours softly to create a second layer.

3rd Layer - Green - Mix a drop of green food coloring with ¼ cup of cold water and pour carefully and gently against the side of the jar for the 3rd layer.

4th layer - Yellow - Pour in ¼ cup of olive oil, again very carefully to create the fourth layer which is yellow.

5th and final layer - mix one drop of red food coloring with ¼ of rubbing alcohol and pour in carefully to create the top layer of your rainbow.

Let it set, and watch your rainbow in a jar!
