

Turtle Rocks

1. Find some rocks!



Take 3 craft sticks to use as guides in finding the perfect rocks. Look for a rock that lays flat, is shaped like an ellipsoid or an ovoid and at least 3" long. When you lay the craft sticks under it like in the picture, you should be able to see the craft sticks sticking out.



2. Rock Scrubbing.

You will need: a bowl, a small water pitcher, eye-dropper bottle filled with dishwashing soap, an old toothbrush, a mat to protect the surface, a sponge and towel for clean up

3. Paint (if you want)

Paint your rock green (make sure it is dry) and the 3 craft sticks brown.

4. Make your turtles!

You will need: some heavy-duty glue (like Tacky Glue,) a mat to protect the surface, a black Sharpie, a dampened sponge for cleanup.

Use the glue to stick the craft sticks to the bottom of the rocks as shown in the above photo. Use the Sharpie to draw eyes, nose and mouth on the stick that is the head, and draw claws on the four sticks that are the legs. Decorate the "carapace," any way you want!
