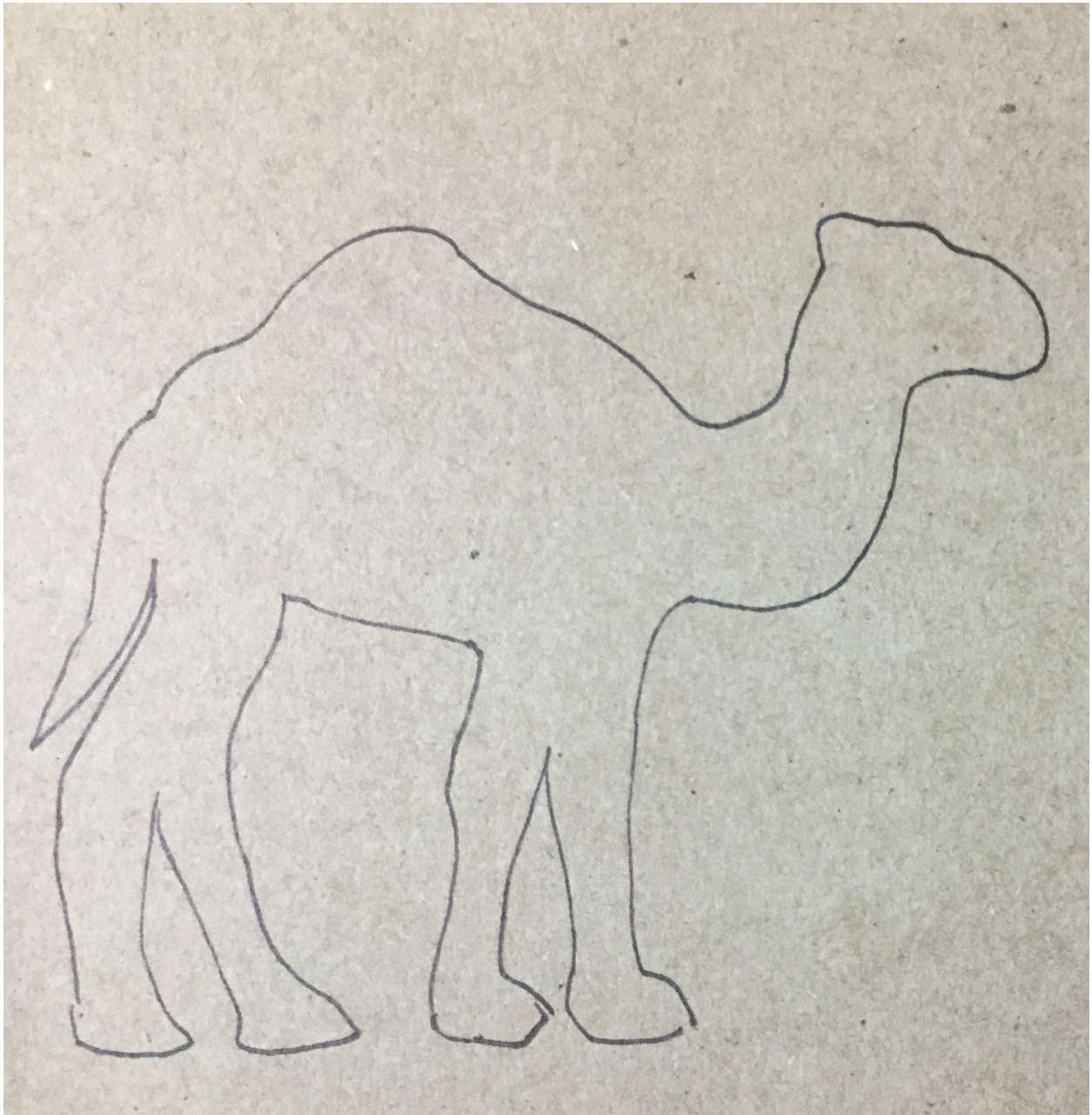


*Would you like to camel race just like  
Etabo in the Wooden Camel story?*

*Here is a way to have your own camel races.*

1. *Trace the pattern onto poster board or light cardboard. Make 2 or more camels if you want to have a race.*



2. *Cut them out and color them. Use several colors because you remember that nature is not 1 color!*



*Remember those loooooong eyelashes that keep out the sand!*

3. *Next cut out some paper and decorate the rugs that will go on the camels' backs. Make each rug different so that you can tell the camel apart during their races!*



*Make them long enough so that they can be folded on the front and back of your camels.*





4. *Cut a straw and tape on the back part of the camel's rug. Depending on where you tape it, the camel may "run" faster. You may have several races before you figure out the most perfect spot!*
5. *Thread a piece of string through the straw. Tie each end across your "racetrack." Make one end a bit higher than the other.*



6. *Do the same with your other camel if you made two. Tie the pieces of string next to each other.*
7. *Now, go to the next file and you will see a very short race!*
