

## 2020-2021 Health & Safety Plan

The following health and safety measures will be in effect August 24-October 22 depending on Lancaster County's re-opening phase set by Governor Wolf. These plans are subject to change. Updates will be emailed and posted at [LCCS.cc/covid-19](http://LCCS.cc/covid-19).

<b>Temperature Checks</b>	Required for students, employees, and visitors prior to entering the building.		Because the Red Phase is a Governor-mandated Stay at Home Order, LCCS will be required to function entirely online.
<b>Hand Sanitizing &amp; Washing</b>	Portable hand-sanitizing stations will be located throughout LCCS in high-traffic areas. Students will be encouraged to sanitize and wash their hands frequently. They will be required to sanitize or wash hands upon entering the building, before/after eating, and before going home. Students may bring their own hand sanitizer for personal use. Personal hand sanitizer may not be shared with others.		
<b>Surface Cleaning</b>	Heavily-used surfaces will be cleaned regularly.		
<b>Air Circulation</b>	Classroom doors and windows will be open whenever possible to increase outside air circulation.		
<b>Social Distancing</b>	Social distancing will be implemented whenever possible.		
<b>Large-Group Gatherings</b>	Held as normal with social-distance seating.		
<b>Fixed Seating</b>	Early Childhood-grade 8 will stay with their class in their classroom for a majority of the day. Exceptions may include lunch, recess, PE, computer, and middle school art, science, and music. Grades 9-12 will rotate through their schedule using multiple classrooms as normal.	All students (preschool-grade 12) will remain with their class in one classroom for a majority of the day. Teachers will rotate in and out as needed. Exceptions may include PE and middle/upper school science.	
<b>Lunch</b>	Smaller lunch shifts will be held in a combination of spaces including the cafeteria, classrooms, and B1/B2 rooms. Students will be required to wash hands or hand sanitize before and after lunch. Hot lunch of individually wrapped items will be provided 3 days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday).	Lunch will be held in the classrooms. Students will be required to wash hands or hand sanitize before and after lunch. Hot lunch of individually wrapped items will be provided 3 days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday).	
<b>Recess</b>	Playgrounds and recess equipment will be cleaned daily. Students will be required to use hand sanitizer before and after recess.	One class at recess in a designated area at a time. Playgrounds and recess equipment will be cleaned between uses. Students will be required to use hand sanitizer before and after recess.	
<b>Masks</b>	Students - optional. Teachers will not be responsible for ensuring that students properly wear their mask. It will be the responsibility of the student if they or their parents choose to have them wear a mask. Employees - optional face shields only. It is important that students feel comfortable and that they are able to see teachers' facial expressions and mouth movements. Clear face shields will be provided for all employees who desire to wear one.	Students - optional. Teachers will not be responsible for ensuring that students properly wear their mask. It will be the responsibility of the student if they or their parents choose to have them wear a mask. Employees - face shield required. It is important that students feel comfortable and that they are able to see teachers' facial expressions and mouth movements. Clear face shields will be provided for all employees.
