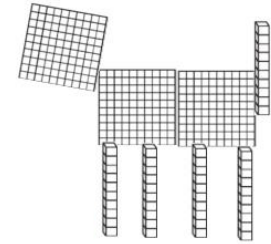
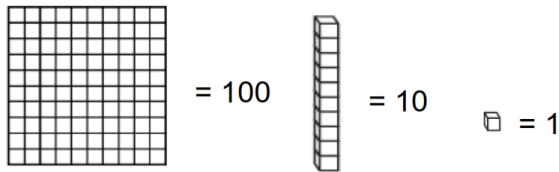


Base Ten Pictures
