


Directions: Fill the Grid



Materials: dice, grid paper, 2 different colored crayons or markers

- 1. Each pair shares one grid. Each player uses a different colored crayon or marker.
- 2. On your turn, roll 2 dice and use the numbers as factors for a rectangle. (Ex. If you roll a 1 and 2, your rectangle's dimensions are 1 by 2)
- 3. Draw and color in your rectangle on the grid sheet. Label the area inside your rectangle.
- 4. Continue taking turns.
- 5. The GOAL is to cover more area than your partner on the grid. (*if you cannot fit your rectangle on the grid on your turn, you must forfeit that turn)
