



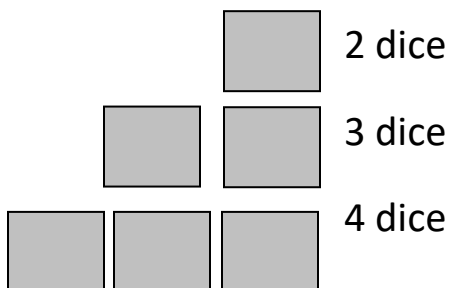

*This activity can be completed independently or with a partner.*

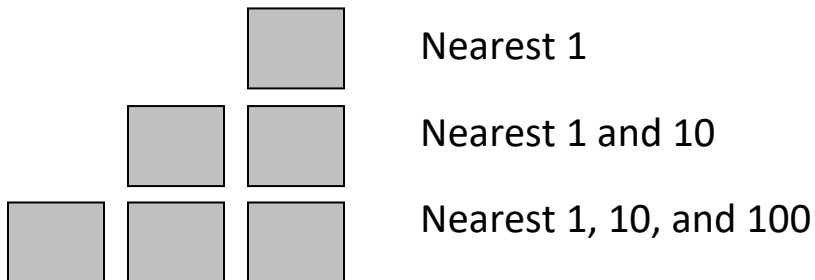
1. Roll:
