
Start

Put and in a .

Get 6 red squares.

Get 6 blue squares.

Number tiles 0 and 3, paper bag, 6 red squares, 6 blue squares

Oral

Directions

TRY Give 6 red squares to one player. Give 6 blue squares to the other player. Take turns. Pick a tile from the bag. Say the number. Name the shape next to that number. Look on the game board. Find a shape that has the same name. Trace that shape with your finger. If the shape is a circle, tell why it is a circle. If the shape is a triangle, tell why it is a triangle. Cover that shape with a square. Put the tile back in the bag. Take turns until one player wins. You can see the ways to win below the game board.


