


Materials Number tiles 4–8, paper bag, 40 squares

Oral<br/>DirectionsTRYWork together. Pick a tile from the bag. Count that number of squares. Find a shape you can make<br/>with that number of squares. Use your squares to make that shape. Keep picking a tile and making a<br/>shape until every shape on the page is filled with squares and the bag of tiles is empty.

**TRY AGAIN** If you have time, remove the squares from each shape one at a time. Count as you remove them. Point to a shape. Ask your partner to make that shape. Or, use squares to make your own shapes!

**TRY AGAIN** If you have time, tell which letter is made with the fewest squares. Tell which letter is made with the most squares. Tell which letters are made with the same number of squares. Then use squares to make other letters.
