<p>Design a playground using paper tubes, paper and materials you find outside. How high up is your tallest slide?</p>	<p>Create a decoration for your room using recycled materials.</p>	<p>Design a mask to wear then act like a new character when wearing your mask.</p>
<p>Create a pencil topper using items around the house.</p> 	<p>FREE</p>	<p>Choose three colors of paint. Can you create 20 new colors from the colors you chose.</p>
