Ten ways to use words to help others have a GREAT day at McGaugh Elementary School!

1.	Introduce yourself to others:	"Hello, my name is, what's your name?
2.	Greet people politely:	"Good Morning Good Afternoon Good Evening!"
3.	Show respect for adults:	Always address adults as Mr., Ms., or Mrs.
4.	Use the magic words:	"Please Thank you You're WelcomeExcuse me"
5.	Praise another person:	"Great job! I can tell you did your best!"
6.	Apologize for mistakes:	"I'm sorry, I didn't mean to"
7.	Offer to help others:	"Is there anything I can do to help you?"
8.	Encourage others:	"I know you can do it keep trying!"
9.	Point out good things:	"It's a great day to be a McGaugh Sea Lion!"
10.	Discourage bullying:	"It's important to be nice to"

Sea Lions <u>NEVER</u> use the "Terrible Ten"

Ten ways to use words that are not acceptable at McGaugh Elementary School!

- 1. Using curse words or foul language.
- 2. Using words to tease another others.
- 3. Using words to embarrass other students or hurt their feelings.
- 4. Using words to threaten other students.
- 5. Spreading rumors or gossiping.
- 6. Making comments about someone's race.
- 7. Complaining about being asked to work hard in school.
- 8. Raising your voice or yelling at someone.
- Making up stories to "be cool".
- 10. Talking back to an adult.



Expectations for a Bully-free School:

- We're a "Hands-off" School!
- Playing safely on the playground
- Be in control of your body!
 - Play-fighting leads to problems and isn't okay
- Lend a <u>HELPING</u> hand... if someone is hurt, find an adult quickly!



Expectations for a Bully-free:

- Help make McGaugh a Bully-Free Zone!
- Never spread a rumor
- Use the "Terrific Ten"
