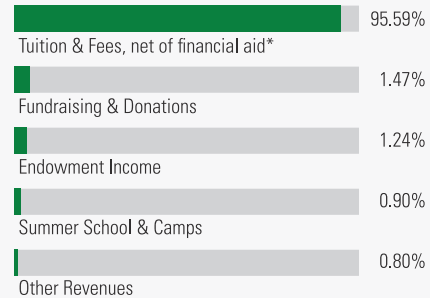


2018-2019 OPERATING INCOME AND EXPENDITURES

SCHOOL INCOME

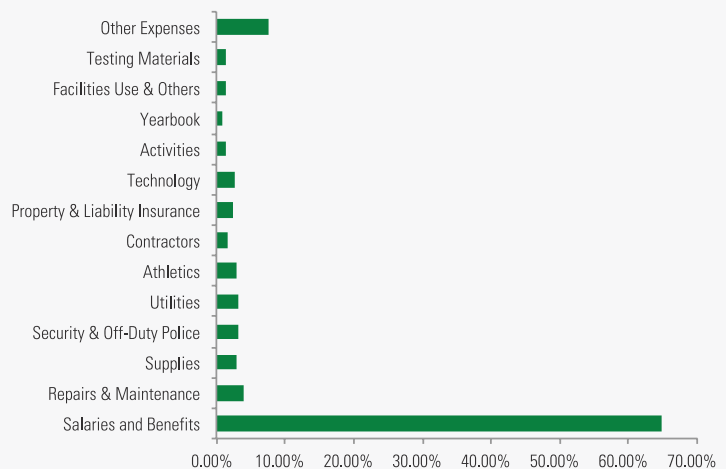

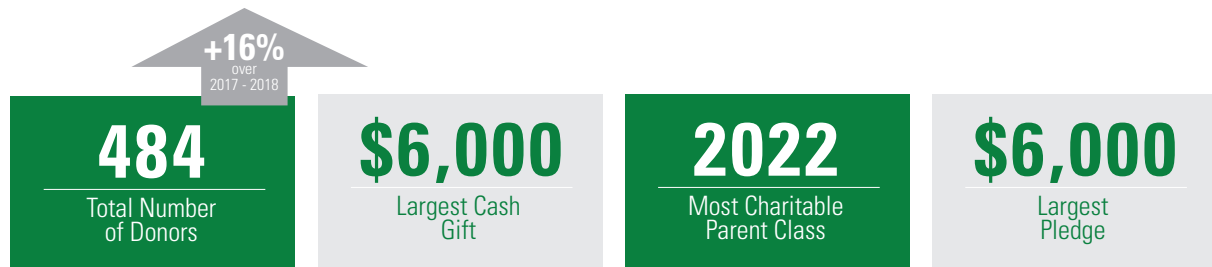

During this pivotal year of expansion, our community came together and made great strides that deserve to be recognized. The many contributions received in time, talent and resources provided exceptional opportunities for our students to both learn and grow.

We are deeply grateful to all of our supporters listed in this Annual Report of Giving. Their actions underscore a commitment to St. Brendan's institutional needs. 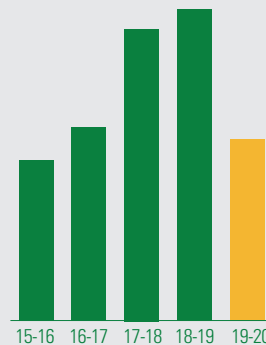

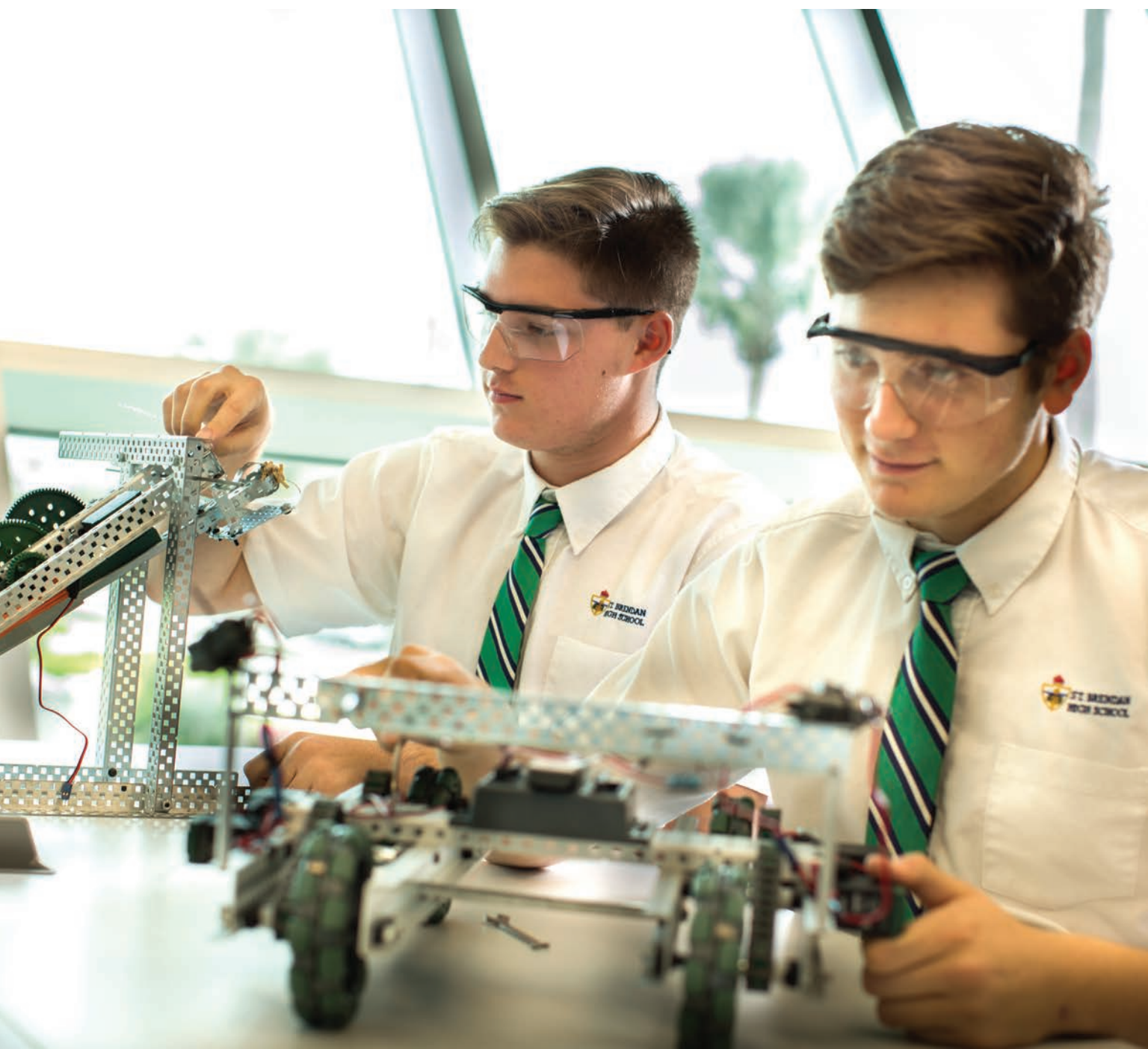
