Dear New Boarding Parent/Agent/Guardian,

I hope you are well and that your son is looking forward to joining Campbell College in August. We continue to live in strange times but the hope is that the new school year will allow us to increasingly return to 'normality'.

I do trust that your son is excited about joining his new school but there will be the inevitable trepidation for someone new, and, at this stage, a little strange; this is inevitable. Ironically, hopefully the Covid experience has actually heightened his excitement to get back to school – it is certainly doing so as far as my three boys go!

As I write, there is still some degree of uncertainty as we await communication from the Government and Department of Education for the reopening of the College. We have provided a joining pack as follows and we will be establishing a dedicated 'Return to College' page on the College website during the summer that will be refreshed as the guidelines evolve and will include a FAQ section.

Arrival for the Start of Term

Students arriving from outside the United Kingdom

At the time of writing, the UK government have stipulated that all travelers arriving from outside the United Kingdom will be required to quarantine for 14 days. We hope this will be reduced in due course. We recommend parents begin to make some enquiries with your nominated guardians/friends in the event this is definitely required in August.

We have been asked if the College can provide a quarantine facility, however, I am sure you understand this is a complicated process in terms of staffing and insurance. If we are able to provide this, information will be updated on the website.

We recommend families hold off on booking flights at the moment in case the quarantine requirement is indeed changed.

Students arriving from within the United Kingdom and Ireland

School is due to commence fully on **Tuesday 1st September** with our Boarding House opening fully on **Monday 31st August**. Students from within the UK should aim to arrive on **Monday 31st August**, check in will be available throughout the day.

It is envisaged that there will be a phased return with not all pupils being on campus at once and we will follow the guidelines set by the Department of Education, the Education Authority and the Public Health Agency around how we phase this return. Please note, if phasing is required, boarders will be supported with their learning from their Boarding House.

Uniform and Kit List

The School Uniform Shop will be operating an appointment booking system due to current restrictions as a result of Covid-19. The booking system will hopefully go live on the College website on 1st July.

It is essential that you complete and return the pre-order form AND make an appointment via the online booking system to collect your order in August.

The clothing list is by no means exhaustive and my experience has been such that all families have slightly variant ideas. Invoicing

Invoices are split into 3 installments. The invoice for the first term's fees will be sent to you in July, we would require this to be paid before your son starts in August.
