ADVANTAGES

- ✓ **Flexible Scheduling:**
One-to-one sessions mean scheduling is flexible and can be tailored to the needs of the family.
- ✓ **Individualized Approach:**
One-to-one sessions mean pre-assessments allow faculty to create personalized plans to best serve the student.
- ✓ **Hourly Packages:**
Families can purchase services in hourly packages and choose how to allocate these hours over the 11 weeks of summer.

SUMMER SAT PREPARATION

Personalized, one-to-one tutoring and preparation for the SAT exam includes individualized contact with an SMS faculty member and digital practice materials.

• 40 Hour Package: \$2000

Includes 40 hours of "live" individual tutoring for the new SAT test-taker, using full-length practice exams and personalized lessons based on student strengths and needs. Students will receive 20 hours of reading/writing tutoring and 20 hours of mathematics tutoring specifically tailored towards increasing performance on the SAT exam. In between sessions, enrichment activities organized and assigned by the faculty member will allow students to practice independently.

• 20 Hour Package: \$1100

Includes 20 hours of individual tutoring for the SAT taker in need of strategies and skill-building to improve SAT performance. Hours for reading/writing tutoring and mathematics tutoring will be distributed based on student need.


• 10 Hour Package: \$600

Includes 10 hours of individual tutoring for the SAT taker in need of specific support in one focus area to improve SAT test performance.

Academic Coaching

Academic coaching focuses on strengthening organizational skills through structure, routine, and research-proven systems. Previewing and priming for content and skills coming in the 2020–2021 academic year is a primary focus of academic coaching. An individual plan for the entirety of the sessions will be developed with the student and family depending upon the number of sessions and desired outcomes.

Math Skills Bootcamp

For students in need of targeted mathematics remediation, enrichment, or previewing, this Bootcamp is designed based on the student's particular needs. For incoming St. Margaret's students, this Bootcamp includes the math placement test and targets instruction accordingly. For returning SMS students, this Bootcamp is designed to prepare for a strong start to the 2020–2021 academic year.

Language Lab for English Language Learners

For students in need of English language support and enrichment, this Language Lab focuses on all four communication skills: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. The Language Lab is designed based on the student's needs and current placement. Language Lab is for English language learners of all levels, including those SMS students headed to university in the fall who may need to continue practice in academic English.

Summer Reading Together

For students who may need additional support to accomplish summer reading work, Summer Reading Together allows for guided reading, reading check-ins for understanding, discussions around the texts, reading comprehension strategy support, and corresponding writing practice.

Master Classes (Current SMS Students)

Remote SMS Master Classes are six hours in duration, spread over two days. They are small group classes taught by an SMS faculty member.
