**Northshore School District to offer meals for all children this summer**

*Expanded summer meal program with 23 pickup locations*

Bothell, Wash. – The Northshore School District will serve breakfast and lunch at no charge to all children who are 18 and younger. Children do not have to be enrolled in the District to receive this benefit.

Seven-day meal packs, which will include breakfast and lunch, will be available to order for pick up at 23 locations across the District. Meals will be available for pick up once a week beginning Wednesday, July 1 and every Thursday from July 9 to Aug. 13. Meals must be ordered [online](#) between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. the Sunday before the meal pick up date. The first meals for pick up can be ordered beginning at 8 a.m. on Sunday, June 28 for the July 1 pick up date.

“The Northshore School District has worked diligently to provide as many resources and supports as possible during the pandemic,” said Northshore’s Food Services Director Juliana Fisher. “We know that many families are going into the summertime with more insecurity than in recent years. We are thrilled to be able to continue supporting our community with meals throughout the summer. This is one thing they won’t have to worry about over the next few months.”
