Theme: It's a Wild World: Africa! The Sahara Science Topic: Living things and their Habitats Term 1.1 Learning Challenge: Do we live in the city or the desert? Week 3 Learning Challenge Question: How do animals adapt to the desert?

How do Meerkats adapt to the desert?



We used the non-fiction text, *Meerkats are Awesome!* to find and learn facts about Meerkats. To answer our Learning Challenge question we learned to describe the location and **conditions** of the Kalahari Desert. Other information we gathered on meerkats helped us interpret and understand our English text in more depth.



How you can help us with our Learning Challenge at home: Can you find even more information about Meerkats?

English Text ~ Meerkat Mail

Meerkat Mail tells the adventures of Sunny the Meerkat as he travels from his home in the Kalahari Desert to other habitats. He is a very endearing, lovable character which children love.

We are creating story maps and retelling the story in preparation for writing postcards as Sunny in the coming weeks.

English ~ Phonics and Spelling

In the first weeks of Year 2 we are revising some **Phase 5 graphemes** - the alternative spellings for certain sounds. We are introducing **homophones**, words that sound the same but are spelt differently and have different meanings. Learning homophones shows us the importance of choosing the correct graphemes for spelling. We see this in words such as *blew* and *blue*. This will be one of our important **strategies for spelling** we focus on this year.
