
What colour is dark? Can we paint the dark?

We were asked questions: Is it only black or are there other colours we see in the dark? What can be seen in the sky? What colours can we see in the rest of the painting? We then created our own night

sky artworks which we look forward to seeing displayed.

Phonics ~ aw, wh, ph



Maths - Addition and Subtraction using number lines


We have begun work again on addition and subtraction, this time using number lines as our calculation strategy.

A common mistake is to miscount jumps on the number line.


